Christina Ivanovna Gildman (aged 43, housekeeper for Fr Leopold Braun, arrested in early 1948 on charges of having 'maintained a criminal connection with the American spies [Fr Leopold] Braun and [Fr Antoine] Laberge, having visited their apartments and given them slanderous and espionage information about the USSR' despite her illiteracy, sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Temlag)
