Fr Waclaw Jaziewicz (aged 40, arrested in Nesvizh on August 2, 1948; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 25 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Ozerlag in Russia)

#### **Belarus: Minsk**

Fr Stanislaw Lazar (aged 43, arrested on July 20, 1948; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, later sent to Minlag in Russia)

# Russia: Kaluga

Sr Raisa Krylevskaya OP (aged 52, arrested in Kostroma on October 9, 1933; another prisoner testified on November 16, 1933 "Raisa Ivanovna Krylevskaya was endlessly devoted to Mother Catherine Abrikosova and Bishop [Eugene] Neveu. In her words, she would follow them 'to the firing squad'"; under interrogation in Moscow on December 6, 1933 said "I have expressed counter-revolutionary views, directed against the policies of the Party and Soviet authority. I stand by my counter-revolutionary views even now. I have not changed them and do not choose to do so. I am a fundamental opponent of the policy being carried out by Soviet power both in the city and in the countryside"; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on February 19, 1934; released from a labor camp in the Komi ASSR in October 1943, sent into internal exile to Kazakhstan; released from internal exile in the spring of 1947; UPDATE: arrested on espionage charges)

Sr Sophia Eismont OP (aged 48, arrested in Ryazan on August 15, 1933, sent to Moscow; sentenced on February 19, 1934 to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Bamlag; arrested on February 2, 1935, sent to Ukhtpechlag; transferred to Vorkutlag in 1938; released on June 23, 1942; **UPDATE**: arrested)
