### Russia: Chuma

Adele Dirsyte (aged 40, teacher, former Caritas director, helped hide Jews during the German occupation, arrested on March 6, 1944 in Vilnius, Lithuania for hiding an escapee from the Soviets; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment on November 11, 1946; sent to a labor camp at Chuma in the summer of 1947; **UPDATE**: transferred to a labor camp at Taishet in the summer of 1949)

### Russia: Kraslag labor camp, Tugachinsk section, Krasnoyarsk region

Fr Adolf Iwancow (aged 39, arrested in 1945; sentenced on March 27, 1946 to 4 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; sent to Pechorlag on May 14, 1946, later transferred to Kraslag; UPDATE: released, later emigrated to Poland)

## Russia: Vorkutlag labor camp

Fr Jan Cegielski (arrested in Ukraine in 1945; **UPDATE**: secretly exercised his ministry while working as a member of a travelling musical ensemble, fate unknown)

# Kazakstan: Karlag labor camp, Akmolinsk sector

Fr Jan Krukowski (aged 73, arrested by the Soviets in Grodno, Belarus on December 13, 1944; sentenced to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on October 28, 1946; arrived at Intlag

in Russia on November 29, 1947; transferred to Karlag on June 9, 1948; **UPDATE**: died, exact date unknown)
