Tuesday February 8, 1949



Hungary: Budapest

Cardinal Jozsef Mindszenty (aged 56, arrested on treason and conspiracy charges in Esztergom on December 26, 1948 after he opposed state seizure of church schools and farmland; **UPDATE**: convicted at the end of a five day trial in which he showed obvious signs of torture and of having been drugged to plead guilty, sentenced to life imprisonment)

Fr Karol Kozera OCD (aged 33, arrested by the Gestapo in Vilnius in 1942, sent to a concentration camp, later freed by Soviet soldiers; **UPDATE**: arrested)

Fr Anton Kuyava (aged 41, arrested by the Gestapo in 1943, released after a few months; **UPDATE**: arrested, accused of anti-Soviet activities, tortured with sleep deprivation)

Bishop Alexandru Rusu (aged 64, arrested in Baia Mare, Maramures on October 28, 1948, sent to Dragoslavele; UPDATE: transferred to Caldarusani)

Bishop Ioan Balan (aged 70, arrested in Lugoj on October 28, 1948, sent to Dragoslavele; **UPDATE**: transferred to Caldarusani)

Bishop Iuliu Hossu (aged 64, arrested in Cluj on October 28, 1948, sent to Dragoslavele; **UPDATE**: transferred to Caldarusani)

Bishop Valeriu Traian Frentiu (aged 74, arrested in Oradea on October 28, 1948, sent to a camp in Dragoslavele; **UPDATE**: transferred to Caldarusani in or after February 1949)

Bishop Vasile Aftenie (aged 48, arrested in Bucharest on October 29, 1948, sent to Dragoslavele; **UPDATE**: transferred to Caldarusani)
