### Czechoslovakia: Spisske Podhradie

Bishop John Vojtassak (aged 72, arrested on [May 5, 1945](#) for having served in the wartime Slovak government; released in Bratislava on [September 8, 1945](#); **UPDATE**: placed under house arrest after opposing the government takeover of religious schools)

### Kazakhstan: Steplag labor camp

Fr Wladyslaw Kisel (aged 56, arrested in [Vilnius, Lithuania](#) on [December 1, 1944](#); sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on [August 22, 1945](#), sent to [Karlag](#) and later to Steplag; **UPDATE**: [died](#))
