Fr Wladyslaw Kisel (aged 56, arrested in Vilnius, Lithuania on December 1, 1944; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on August 22, 1945, sent to Karlag and later to Steplag; **UPDATE**: died)
