Fr Stanislaw Dziadek (aged 61, arrested on July 22, 1950; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp followed by 5 years' internal exile, sent to a Gushosdor highway labor camp in Kharkiv oblast)

Fr Adam Czubek (aged 64, sentenced to 25 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Rivne Prison)

#### Albania

Sr Maria Tucci (aged 22, elementary school teacher, postulant, arrested on August 10, 1949, beaten, tortured, sexually assaulted; **UPDATE**: died from the effects of torture [had been placed in a sack with a cat which was then beaten, developed massive infections from the bites and scratches], said "I thank God because he gave me the force to die free")
