Monday December 4, 1950



Kazakhstan: Steplag labor camp, Dzhezkazgan, Karaganda oblast

Fr Franciszek Janocha OFM (aged 38, arrested in Lviv by the Soviets in July 1940, sentenced to death, commuted to imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Unzhlag; amnestied as a Polish citizen on September 2, 1941; appointed chaplain of the Polish Armed Forces of the East on March 1, 1942 in Chok-Pak, Kazakhstan; arrested in Turkmenistan on March 20, 1943 on anti-Soviet and espionage charges; sentenced on September 8, 1943 to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Ukhtizhemlag; transferred to Steplag in 1948; UPDATE: released, sent into internal exile to the Taseyevsk region, Krasnoyarsk Krai)
