China

Archbishop Cyril Rudolph Jarre OFM (aged 74, German national, died in prison from untreated illnesses)

March 1952, date unknown



Kazakhstan: Steplag labor camp, Dzhezkazgan, Karaganda oblast

Fr Anton Kuyava (aged 44, arrested in Jazno, Belarus on February 17, 1949, accused of anti-Soviet activities, tortured with sleep deprivation; sentenced in Dzisna, Belarus to 25 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on May 21, 1949; sent to Steplag on July 25 1949, arrived seriously ill; **UPDATE**: began to show signs of active tuberculosis)

Fr Stefan Kostial (aged 38, arrested in church in 1951 while hearing confessions, tortured; escaped from a hospital in Bratislava on February 19, 1952, had been hospitalized to recover from torture; **UPDATE**: recaptured)
