Fr Michal Aronowicz (aged 45, arrested in Belarus on charged of 'contacts with Polish nationalists' on February 17, 1951; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on August 11, 1951; arrived at camp on October 4, 1951; **UPDATE**: released, sent to Minsk Prison)
