Russia: Vorkutlag labor camp

Fr Michal Drabik (aged 41, arrested in Sambor, Ukraine on January 12, 1945; sentenced on July 17, 1947 in Drohobych, Ukraine to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: released from the labor camp but denied the right to leave - effectively sentenced to internal exile, settled in Vorkuta)

Kazakhstan: Steplag labor camp, Dzhezkazgan, Karaganda

Fr Alexander Ben (aged 42, arrested in Zhytomyr, Ukraine on January 26, 1945; sentenced in Kiev on May 6, 1946 to 8 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: released from imprisonment, sent into internal exile to Kokchetavsk, Kazakhstan)

Christians were killed for refusing to take unchristian oaths in support of Mau Mau guerrillas

Gadson Gachigi (husband of Rebeka Gachigi, father of Timothy, carpenter, strangled)

Rebeka Gachigi (wife of Gadson Gachigi, mother of Timothy and one unborn child, teacher, strangled)

Timothy (aged 1 year, orphan child of Gadson and Rebeka Gachigi)

Nathaniel (friend of Gadson Gachigi, strangled)

Heshbon Mwangi (preached at the funeral of Gadson and Rebeka Gachigi and Nathaniel)
