Fr William Booth MM (aged 54, U.S. citizen, arrested by North Korean forces in Seoul, South Korea on July 2, 1950, forced to march to Pyongyang, North Korea; after a trial forced to march to the Yalu without food or shelter; absolved Bishop Patrick James Byrne before his death on November 25, 1950; **UPDATE**: released)

Fr W. Aedan McGrath SSC (aged 48, Irish citizen, imprisoned in September 1951, tortured; **UPDATE**: released, expelled from the country)
