Russia: Kamyshlag labor camp

Fr Ryszard Grabski OFM Cap (aged 44, captured by German border guards in occupied Poland while illegally crossing from Soviet held territory in 1940, handed over to Soviet border guards, sent to Belostok Prison; sent to Kotlas, Arkhangelsk oblast, Russia in May 1941; arrested on August 23, 1942; sentenced on October 2, 1943 to 15 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Vorkutlag, later transferred to Kamyshlag; **UPDATE**: transferred to Steplag in Kazakhstan)
