Saturday November 3, 1954



Russia: Angarlag labor camp, Irkutsk region

Sr Sophia Eismont OP (aged 54, arrested in Kaluga on November 30, 1948; sentenced on August 17, 1949 to 10 year's imprisonment in a labor camp; **UPDATE**: released, exiled to Kazakhstan)

Russia: Siblag labor camp, Novosibirsk

Fr Wladyslaw Kurp-Garbowski (aged 70, arrested in Lithuania on June 11, 1950; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on November 29, 1950, sent to Temlag; **UPDATE**: released from camp due to illness [had been transferred from Temlag earlier in the year], later emigrated to Poland)

Russia: Vorkutlag labor camp

Fr Bronislaw Drzepecki (aged 48, arrested by the Soviets in Zhytomyr, Ukraine on January 10, 1945; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on March 6, 1946; **UPDATE**: released from camp, kept in internal exile in Vorkuta, later sent to Akmolinsk oblast in Kazakhstan)

Sunday November 18, 1954



Russia: Minlag labor camp, Inta village, Kozhvinsk region, Komi ASSR

Fr Dionizy Kajetanowicz (aged 76, arrested in Lviv, Ukraine on November 27, 1945 after refusing to join the Orthodox church; sentenced on March 9, 1946 to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Stalinsk oblast; transferred to Minlag in April 1950; UPDATE: died)
