Fr Vojtech Basovnik SDB (aged 42, placed under house arrest in April 1950; sentenced on September 24, 1953 to four years' imprisonment; sent to the Rtyne v Podkrkonosí, Tmavak prison camp in May 1954, worked in coal and uranium mines; **UPDATE**: hospitalized with a large abscess)

Russia: Minlag labor camp, Inta village, Kozhvinsk region, Komi ASSR

Fr Stanislaw Lazar (aged 49, arrested in Minsk, Belarus on July 20, 1948; sentenced on November 12, 1948 to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; arrived at Minlag on May 11, 1949; granted a conditional early release on July 14, 1954; **UPDATE**: allowed to return to Belarus, was unable to return to his ministry)
