## Kazakstan: Karlag labor camp

Fr Czeslaw Barwicki (aged 47, arrested in Polatsk on August 21, 1948; sentenced on January 7, 1949 to 25 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; transferred from Sevpechlag labor camp, outside Vorkuta on October 14, 1951; UPDATE: released)

## Russia: Usollag labor camp, Solikamsk, Perm region

- Fr Kazimierz Lendzyon CSSR (aged 43, monastery in Sambir, Ukraine closed in 1950; arrested on July 11, 1952; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp on August 19, 1952; **UPDATE**: granted an early release, returned to Sambir, later emigrated to Poland)
- Fr Martin Karas CSSR (aged 46, arrested in Stryi, Ukraine on July 13, 1952; sentenced on August 19, 1952 to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; sent to Usollag in Russia on October 20, 1952; UPDATE: released early, returned to Stryi)

**Russia: Karaganda oblast** 

Fr Władysław Bukowiński (aged 52; arrested by the Soviets in Lutsk on January 3, 1945; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; granted early release on August 14, 1954, retained in Karaganda in internal exile; **UPDATE**: released from internal exile, remained in Karaganda)
