Cardinal Jozsef Mindszenty (aged 64, arrested on treason and conspiracy charges in Esztergom on December 26, 1948 after he opposed state seizure of church schools and farmland; convicted in Budapest at the end of a five day trial on February 8, 1949 in which he showed obvious signs of torture and of having been drugged to plead guilty, sentenced to life imprisonment; released from prison by revolutionaries on October 30, 1956; UPDATE: granted asylum at the United States Embassy)

Poland: Warsaw

Sr Zofia Luszczkiewicz (aged 58, arrested in Wadowice on August 27, 1948 for aiding an anti-Communist politician, tortured; convicted in Warsaw on espionage and 'attempting to change the state system' charges on November 23, 1949, sentenced to 15 years' imprisonment, the prosecutor appealed and obtained a death sentence; sentence commuted to life imprisonment on March 13, 1950; UPDATE: released from prison due to poor health)
