Russia: Kostroma region

Fr Anton Bankowski (aged 48, arrested in Rakov, Grodno region, Belarus on January 3, 1948, later sentenced to 25 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; arrived at Vorkutlag labor camp on February 6, 1948; transferred to a labor camp in Kostroma region on June 2, 1955; **UPDATE**: released)

Russia: Siblag labor camp

Janina Lesniewska (aged 33-35, arrested on espionage charges in Moscow in September 1949; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp in November 1949, possibly sent to Siblag; UPDATE: released early, returned to Moscow)

Fr Vladimir Borovets (aged 69, arrested in 1946; **UPDATE**: released, emigrated to Poland)

Russia: Ukhtizhemlag labor camp, Sosnovka, Komi ASSR

Fr Longins Lapkovskis SJ (aged 45, arrested in 1951 in Riga, Latvia, sentenced to a camp, sent to a Volga-Don Canal construction camp, then to a camp in Karelia, then to Ukhtizhemlag; **UPDATE**: released, returned to Latvia and resumed his ministry)

Ukraine: Kopelyanka, Khoroshiv district, Zhytomyr oblast

Fr Faustin Lisicki (aged 54, arrested in Zhytomyr on February 25, 1946; sentenced on August 1, 1946 to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp; arrived at Vorkutlag in Russia on November 3, 1947; transferred to Intlag on May 16, 1955; released on February 25, 1956, returned to Zhytomyr; **UPDATE**: arrested, released after several months)

Ukraine: Zhytomyr

Fr Roman Jankowski (aged 69, arrested in Kotelnia on counter-revolutionary charges on August 27, 1935; sentenced on August 14, 1936 to 5 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent into internal exile following his release; returned from internal exile in 1945 and resumed his ministry, soon forced to live in Yablonna; returned to Zhytomyr in 1951; UPDATE: banned from ministry for a year)

Lithuania

Fr Juozanas Gustas SDB (arrested by the Soviets in Saldutishkis, Lithuania, exact year unknown but possibly 1944, later sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment in a labor camp, sent to Siblag in Russia; released in 1956, returned to Lithuania; UPDATE: voluntarily went to Krasnoyarsk in Russia to serve exiled Lithuanians)

Slovenia: Ljubljana

Fr Anton Strie (aged 42, jailed for 3 months' in Ljubljana in 1945; imprisoned in Ljubljana in 1947; released in 1952 in Medvodah; **UPDATE**: sentenced to prison for 6 months, released after 2 months)
