Bishop Stepan Trochta SDB (aged 55, arrested by the Gestapo on May 28, 1942, sent to Terezin, Mauthausen and Dachau concentration camps; under house arrest by the StB in 1951, forced to sign allegiance to the socialist republic while under the likely influence of narcotics; arrested in 1953; sentenced to 25 years' imprisonment in 1954; **UPDATE**: released in an amnesty, forced to work as a plumber)
