Czechslovakia: Leopoldov prison

Bishop Pavel Peter Gojdic OSBM (aged 72, issued a pastoral letter from Presov on January 25, 1939 concerning the government's "Program for the Solution of the Jewish Question" and predicted disaster should it be implemented; accused by the government on October 26, 1942 of protecting Jews by engaging in ficticious conversions; arrested on April 28, 1950 for refusing to merge his church into the Russian Orthodox Church; convicted of treason in January 1951, sentenced to life imprisonment; **UPDATE**: died of cancer in the prison hospital, had been tortured)
