May 1966, date unknown



China: Tilanqiao Prison, Shanghai

Lin Zhao aka Peng Lingzhao (aged 33, convert, writer and poet, former communist, arrested on [October 14, 1960](#); released from prison in [March 1962](#) for a hospital stay; arrested in [early November 1962](#), tortured, wrote anti-Communist writings with her own blood while imprisoned; tried on [May 31, 1965](#), sentenced to 20 years' imprisonment; **UPDATE**: said during a prison visit of a friend that the authorities had decided to execute her and asked that he help her family after her death, said she was beaten daily by compliant prisoners, and feared that she would be raped, was seen to smile and cry for the first time in her imprisonment)
