Boris Vladimirovich Talantov (aged 68, widower of Nina Agafangelovna Talantova, signed an open letter on March 30, 1968 which criticized the Moscow Patriarchate for its cooperation with the Soviet regime; arrested on June 12, 1968; sentenced on September 3, 1968 to 2 years' imprisonment for anti-Soviet activities; **UPDATE**: died in prison from heart disease)
