Cardinal Jozsef Mindszenty (aged 79, convicted in Budapest at the end of a five day trial on February 8, 1949 in which he showed obvious signs of torture and of having been drugged to plead guilty, sentenced to life imprisonment; released from prison by revolutionaries on October 30, 1956; granted asylum at the United States Embassy in Budapest on November 4, 1956; UPDATE: allowed to leave the Embassy and the country)
