Cambodia: Kdol Leu

Fr Pierre Rapin (aged 45, French national, seriously injured by an explosive device planted by the Khmer Rouge, taken to a Khmer Rouge hospital, died, injection with poison had been suspected since he was not at risk of imminent death when taken, among his last words were "My son...if those who wanted to kill me are captured, forgive them, do them no harm! Revenge is useless. Dearest son...have faith in God...I loved our Christians so dearly...")
