Virginijus Ivanovas (detained, interrogated as to his participation in a religious procession to the Hill of Crosses, kept silent, threatened with expulsion from music school, later expelled)

Zenonas Mistautas (fourth year Polytechnical Institute student, detained, interrogated as to his participation in a religious procession to the Hill of Crosses, kept silent, threatened with torture)

Mecislovas Jurevicius (aged 46, detained, interrogated as to his participation in a religious procession to the Hill of Crosses, kept silent, threatened with prison)

**Lithuania: Steponiskis** 

Ms Rudinee (wife of Julius Rudys, mother of Stasys, questioned at her home in Steponiskis by officials on April 6, 1973, turned over a religious liberty petition after threatened with a search, ordered to appear at the district KGB office the next day; questioned on April 7, 1973 in Panevezys as to the organizers of the petition, threatened with loss of her parental rights; **UPDATE**: home searched, religious objects seized, taken to the district KGB office in Panevezys and threated with prison and a bad characterization on her daughter's school records)

Julius Rudys (father of Stasys, questioned)

Staysis (aged 11, son of Julius Rudys, questioned)

Ms Gudiene (asked why she did not allow her son to join the Young Communist League, replied "Because I don't see any good examples among the Communists. They are dishonest and liars because they themselves secretly take part in religious rites while slandering others who do so", berated for this response)

Ms Murmokiene (asked if she believed in God, answered that she did and always would)

Elena Sulinauskaite (University of Vilnius History department chief laboratory assistant, suspected of being a nun, discharged)

Janina Ivanauskaite (secondary school student, questioned by school authorities on her religious activities, threatened with expulsion)

### Lithuania: Pabaiskas, Ukmerge district

Vale Amankaviciute (secondary school student, publicly told during graduation that her conduct mark had been lowered for attending church)
