**Russia: Moscow** 

Fr Dimitri Dudko (aged 52, husband of Nina, father of Mikhail and Natalya, arrested in 1948 at seminary for having written poems against Stalin, sent to Inta; released in 1956; ordained in 1960; UPDATE: priestly faculties temporarily suspended after he allowed a question to be asked in his church that was critical of the Moscow Patriarch, transferred two weeks later to a church in Kabanovo, two hours from Moscow by rail)

### Monday May 13, 1974



Lithuania: Vosyliskiai, Vosiliskiai district

Fr Jonas Survila (fined 50 rubles on July 17, 1972 for allowing children to serve at Mass; **UPDATE**: summoned to the district executive committee, ordered to explain in writing why boys were allowed to serve at the altar, wrote "Why do I not chase the boys from the altar? I cannot drive them from the altar because, as the Lord Jesus Christ says, 'Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them...' Therefore, 'We must obey God rather than men'", fined 50 rubles upon receipt of his explanation)

### Lithuania: Sates, Skuodas district

Juozas Valanciauskas (parish council chairman, ordered to remove a statue of the Virgin Mary from the churchyard, replied that no parishioner would remove it, the statue remained)

#### Lithuania: Siauliai

Leonas Sileikis (middle school student, asked by his principal and teachers if he had read his assigned atheism texts, said he had and they were "lies and calumnies", refused to renounce his faith when asked)
