Russia: Moscow

Fr Dimitri Dudko (aged 54, husband of Nina, father of Mikhail and Natalya, arrested in 1948 at seminary for having written poems against Stalin; released in 1956; ordained in 1960; priestly faculties temporarily suspended on May 4, 1974 after he allowed a question to be asked in his church that was critical of the Moscow Patriarch, transferred two weeks later to a church in Kabanovo, two hours from Moscow by rail; fired by his bishop in December 1975 for preaching on social problems such as alcoholism and abortion;

UPDATE: assigned to a parish in Grebnevo outside Moscow)
