Russia: Samara

Alexander Ogorodnikov (aged 28, Christian Seminar member, husband of Yelena Levashova, father of Dima; arrested in Redkino for parasitism on November 20, 1978; trial in Konakovo ended on January 11, 1979, refused to confess or show remorse, sentenced to 1 year's imprisonment in Komsomolsk-na-Amur, beaten by police in public after he refused to turn over his trial notes; **UPDATE**: arrived)

Tatiana Shchipkova (Christian Seminar member, teacher, home in Smolensk raided by police on April 21, 1978, Christian underground literature seized; confessed to her students that she

was a Christian on June 7, 1978, fired from her position and stripped of her degrees; **UPDATE**: present during a police raid, struck a policeman, later charged with 'hooliganism')
