Sunday October 23, 1983



Lebanon: Beirut

Two suicide bombers killed 305 people, mostly French and U.S. peacekeepers

Rev Denny G Wheeler (husband of Brenda, chaplain, seriously injured, last person to be pulled from the rubble at the U.S. bombing site to survive)

Fr George Pucciarelli (saw the Advent stole of Rev Denny G Wheeler sticking out of the rubble and began efforts to recover him, also made a kippa from his uniform for chaplain Rabbi Arnold Resnicoff after Resinicoff had used his own kippa to wipe blood from a wounded Marine)
