Cyprien Rugamba (aged 59, husband of Daphrose Mukansanga Rugamba, former seminarian, historian, killed with his wife and 6 of their 10 children while engaged in a prayer vigil because they had opposed the actions which led to the genocide, had taken over 100 street children into his home and evangelized many couples)

Daphrose Mukansanga Rugamba (aged 50, wife of Cyprien Rugamba, former teacher, killed with her husband and 6 of their 10 children)

Fr Ubald Rugirangoga (fled his seminary in Nyundo in February 1973 when it was attacked by Hutus including fellow seminarians; **UPDATE**: approached the local police for protection and for food and water for the 10,000 refugees at his parish, given 4 officers)

UPDATE: parish church attacked by the Hutu militia, falsely accused of being a killer after the police shot a militia member, expelled from the parish and forced to travel to Bishop Thaddee Ntihinyurwa's residence in Cyangugu under police escort)

Bishop Thaddee Ntihinyurwa (**UPDATE**: arrived after receiving a call from Fr Ubald Rugirangoga that his parish was under attack)

Thursday April 14, 1994



Rwanda: Cyangugu

Fr Ubald Rugirangoga (approached the local police on April 10, 1994 for protection and for food and water for the 10,000 refugees at his parish in Nyamasheke, given 4 officers; parish church attacked by the Hutu militia on April 13, 1994, falsely accused of being a killer after the police shot a militia member, expelled from the parish and forced to travel to Bishop Thaddee Ntihinyurwa's residence in Cyangugu under police escort; **UPDATE**: informed by a weeping Bishop Thaddee Ntihinyurwa that the remaining Tutsi religious at his parish had been killed, saw the Bishop's bloodied clothing)

Bishop Thaddee Ntihinyurwa (**UPDATE:** tried to evacuate three religious brothers and then tried to stop their murder by throwing himself between them and their killers, forced to watch their murders, clothing bloodied)

Saturday April 16, 1994



Rwanda: Mugonero

Seven pastors were killed along with their parishioners in the hospital where they had taken refuge, the previous day they had written to their senior pastor "Our dear leader, Pastor Elizaphan Ntakirutimana, How are you! We wish you to be strong in all these problems we are facing. We wish to inform you that we have heard that tomorrow we will be killed with our families. We therefore request you to intervene on our behalf and talk with the Mayor. We believe that, with the help of God who entrusted you the leadership of this flock, which is going to be destroyed, your intervention will be highly appreciated, the same way as the Jews were saved by Esther. We give honor to you", the senior pastor helped organize the killings

Fr Ubald Rugirangoga (approached the local police on April 10, 1994 for protection and for food and water for the 10,000 refugees at his parish in Nyamasheke, given 4 officers; parish church attacked by the Hutu militia on April 13, 1994, falsely accused of being a killer after the police shot a militia member, expelled from the parish and forced to travel to Bishop Thaddee Ntihinyurwa's residence in Cyangugu under police escort; informed by a weeping Bishop Thaddee Ntihinyurwa on April 14, 1994 that the remaining Tutsi religious brothers at his parish had been killed, saw the Bishop's bloodied clothing; UPDATE: informed that all the refugees at his parish had been killed, and his entire family remaining in his home village including his mother had been killed)

Bishop Thaddee Nsengiyumva (aged 45, issued the pastoral letter *Let Us Convert to Live Together in Peace* in Kabgayi in December 1991 in which he decried ethnic hatred, assassinations, government exploitation of division, and Church inaction; **UPDATE**: made repeated appeals to stop the genocide, tried to aid refugees)

Rwanda: Kigali

Fr Andre Sibomana (aged 40, journalist, tried several times in 1990 for publishing information that embarrassed the government, not convicted; **UPDATE**: escaped from the capital, saved many from death, later said "For many people in Rwanda, refraining from murder was, in itself, an act of resistance. Several peasant farmers were killed because they refused to strike the corpses of their Tutsi neighbors. There are courageous and upright men who were not able or did not dare to come to the aid of their fellows and now live with remorse for having failed to do so. There is no merit in my having rescued a few people, because it was in my power to do so. My position gave me a better chance than others")
