**Sunday May 12, 1996** 



Zaire: Monastere Notre-Dame, Mokoto village, Masisi zone, North Kivu

A Trappist monastery sheltering local Tutsis was attacked by local Hutus and Rwandan Hutus from UN supplied refugee camps, over 100 Tutsis were killed and the monastery was destroyed

Fr Dhelo OSCO (abbot, away on business when the attack began, had previously told the Hutus "I said to them that if they thought my death could solve the problem and I would die alone, I would be content to die. After that they didn't come for me")

Fr Victor Bordeau OSCO (French national, one of six monks still present when the attack began and who escaped on a tractor, later said after no humanitarian organization would evacuate the Tutsis from danger because it would violate their mandates: "Everything is lies here. All these organizations – they will give blankets, food, yes. But save lives? No they can't")
