- Amir Ramzi (Criminal Court judge, described his phone call to police from St Mark's Cathedral in which he requested an armored vehicle be sent to protect the cathedral from the attacking mob, only to see Muslim youths atop the arriving vehicle throw stones and Molotov cocktails at the cathedral)
- Wael Eskandar (reported on the attack on St Mark cathedral "The police are not trying to protect us or do anything to stop the violence. On the contrary, they are actively aiding the people in civilian clothes" that had been attacking the Christians)
- Mina Zakaraya (aged 25, seminarian, said "Only God can save us from what is happening right now")
- Makram Girgis (said "I'm worried about the situation in Egypt...The Muslim Brotherhood and extremist groups here want us to leave. They don't accept Copts. But this was our country, ever since the time of the pharaohs.")
