- Wilson Saraj (project manager at Barnabas Aid in London, United Kingdom, several relatives injured in the double suicide bombing of All Saints Church)
- Wilson Chowdhry (Chairman of the British Pakistani Christian Association, said in Paris, France of the bombing of All Saints Church: "My wife lost 13 members of her family in this tragic incident, spanning three generations.
