Bishop Akram Gill (aged 53, sheltered Shehnaz Gill and Sajjida Bibi overnight, brought them to Bishop Jamsheed's residence where the two women were arrested due to the blasphemy charge against Pastor Adnan Prince)

Bishop Jamsheed (attempted to shelter Shehnaz Gill and Sajjida Bibi after Pastor Adnan Prince was accused of blasphemy)

Sabir (business partner of Mushtaq Rehmat, witnessed the alleged blasphemy incident)

Mushtaq Rehmat (husband of Tahira, father of Taniya, Daud, Michal, and Sitaish, business was the location of the alleged blasphemy by Pastor Adnan Prince, named in the police report, arrested)

Tahira (aged 30, wife of Mushtaq Rehmat)

Taniya (aged 14, child of Tahira and Mushtaq Rehmat)

Daud (aged 12, child of Tahira and Mushtaq Rehmat)

Alfiya Kashkumbayev (wife of Pastor Bakhytzhan Kashkumbayev, "is suffering a lot" after her husband's re-arrest according to their son Askar, had been threatened with physical harm by the police for protesting his re-arrest)

In an unusual move, an intermediate [appellate] court has agreed to retry their case.
- Cao Xia (aged @50 [2012], wife of Lu Mingchen, charged with engaging in cult activities, a charge she denies, received a 3.5 year prison sentence; **UPDATE**: an intermediate [appellate] court has agreed to retry her case)
- Han Hai (aged 60 [2012], husband of Xin Jiuni, charged with engaging in cult activities, a charge he denies, received a 7.5 year prison sentence; **UPDATE**: an intermediate [appellate] court has agreed to retry his case)
- Zhang Kai (civil rights lawyer; **UPDATE**: now a visiting scholar at Purdue University, said that the defense team will argue that the law should not define what is a cult and what is not, also said that a significant amount of money was seized from the defendants by the police and then disappeared which raises questions about theft)
