Aleksei Shchedrov (aged 28 [in 2013], as of June 27, 2013 faces a possible maximum sentence of two years imprisonment for operating an unregistered religious organization because he took homeless people into his home for food and prayer, Bibles taken for "expert analysis" during a February 2013 police raid and not returned, police investigation is

continuing; criminal charges dropped on September 11, 2013; **UPDATE**: fined US\$4 for electrical and chimney code violations, legal status of his shelter removed, failed a sanitary inspection despite no water testing of the well and no alternative allowed for bottled water, 13 people may be turned out into the streets, state media perpetrated a smear campaign against him which alleged drug use and cult activities, Bibles and religious literature returned)

Fr Yury Gritsko (said there was no evidence to back the state media smear campaign against Aleksei Shchedrov, said that he brings clergy from all denominations to minister to his shelter residents)

Shagufta Kauser (aged 35, wife of Shafaqat Emmanuel, mother of two, school worker, arrested on or before July 21, 2013 for allegedly sending a blasphemous text message; forced along with her children to watch the torture of her husband by the police on or before August 5, 2013; **UPDATE**: trial pending)
