They continue to treat us second-class citizens. Meanwhile, they use taxes collected from everybody to help Hindus. This cannot be called a secular government")

In recent times it has simply attracted people who use it as a shield to protect their aims. These people consider themselves to be substitutes of God on the Earth, murdering millions of innocent people, casting a shadow over the religion itself")

Middle East's Christians...We in the West, who enjoy so many freedoms and liberties, need to ask ourselves some tough questions about the disproportionate nature of the causes which we so readily embrace whilst ignoring the systematic violent ideology of an Islamist "Final Solution" directed at the Christian minorities...Ultimately, [Western] parliamentarians are only as good as the people who elect them – so their electorates are also partly to blame or not organizing themselves in the way in which pressure groups do. If political leaders have been indifferent, where here are the western churches?")
