UPDATE: Authorities detained 14 Christians on August 7 2014 in a crackdown on unregistered churches following the stabbing death of a woman in a McDonalds by members of the Church of the Almighty God cult, all released on bail

Ning (reported on pressures on Christians "The [authorities] don't allow the church's worshippers to gather together, saying that our house church is not certified. They say we can gather together, but it must be at a Three-Self church...All together, there should be more than 10,000 worshippers in these counties. Now, they can only get together in threes or fives. The electricity for the worshippers was cut, and the eldest worshipper is 81. From Aug. 22 until [Sept. 2], more than a week has passed, and they have spent nights in darkness")

Yu (said "There is minor persecution on gatherings of small groups. They simply brand us whatever they can think of and call us an evil cult when they really should conduct an investigation before they say so")

Gunmen rob residents of a Christian village as they leave it, two cousins shot

Ernst Kamel (cousin of Eid Gendy, shot, left for dead, said "They were ambushing anyone from our village, as all the residents of our village are Christians, to attack him and rob him. The Christians in our village are targeted...Also after our incident the security forces deployed across the village for four days. After they had left the village, the Islamic gangs came back to our village carrying the weapons, terrorizing the Christians, imposing extortion money on them amid a state of indifference and complicity by the police")

Eid Gendy (cousin of Ernst Kamel, shot dead)

Fr Mossa Shaker (said "just a few days after the incident of the shooting of the two Copts, some armed masked Muslim thugs stopped a pickup-truck owned by a Christian man loaded with mango fruit. They seized his pickup-truck and 500 Egyptian pounds from the owner. The Christian residents of Muharraq Monastery village are living in a state of tyranny, bullying, and oppression by the Islamic gangs of three neighboring villages called Alaghima village, the Great Manshiyya village, and Khashba village without any intervention from the police to protect them")

- Fifty Christian leaders issued a report on 600 acts of persecution during the first 100 days of the new BJP government against Christians and Muslims, including the reported Hindu conversion of a Christian congregation in Asroi village, Aligarh district
- Sundar Singh (investigated the Asroi village, Aligarh district incident, said "This is mere propaganda and a ploy to intimidate Christian congregations as a whole. Saffron [Hindu fundamentalist] groups are behind it")
- Fr Dominic Emmanuel (investigated the Asroi village, Aligarh district incident in which the Hindus videographed the 'reconversion' of 72 Christians on YouTube, alleged it was fabricated "It was organized by Hindu fundamentalist outfits capitalizing on the lapse of the pastor. But there are only five Christian families with 30 members in the area")
- Osmond Charles (advocate, said "The series of atrocities did not end with Asroi. At Hasayn in the same district, the pracharaks [Hindu activists] wanted to conduct the same purification inside the church but were stopped by the police")
- Pramod Singh (attorney, reported on the arrest of 12 pastors in Kulesra village, Surajpur district, Uttar Pradesh state "The police chief of the area even told us that 'this is a Hindu nation.' The police have changed colors with the change of government")
- John Dayal (**UPDATE**: said "these incidents are not isolated. There is a clear strategy and plan behind it. Such instances are only spreading")

Rev Samuel Dante Dali (husband of Dr Rebecca Dali, **UPDATE**: wrote that in the previous week "Boko Haram violence has been getting worse every day, and our members are fleeing the area by the thousands. Recent attacks in Borno and Adamawa states where are our churches are located have seen Boko Haram take over the Army base. As a result, about 350 Christians have been killed...Every night at the EYN headquarters, our staff and their families go to bed with hearts bound in fear for their lives. This has forced them to be prepared to flee at any time of the night in an event an attack occurs during the hours of darkness")

Dr Rebecca Dali (wife of Rev Samuel Dante Dali, **UPDATE**: wrote "We are still under turbulence because of Boko Haram – last week they captured a lot of villages in the Madagali areas. Five days ago they overcame the soldiers, occupied the army barracks, and killed more than 350 Christians. Yesterday and today [Sept. 5 and 6] the Boko Haram insurgents were in Gulak, killing a lot of Christians...[A pastor in Gulak] told us

that they vandalized the church and his own property. He also said the gunmen killed a lot of Christians who are from Shuwa, Michika, Watu, and others...We are closing Kulp Bible College for now. Pray for us please")

Luka Sabo (said "They went from house to house shooting and killing those they came in contact with. I have seen bodies of some of those killed, but it is difficult to say how many have died.")

Boko Haram is determined to eliminate every sign of Christian presence...Unfortunately a good number of these displaced persons cannot escape from the combat areas and getting humanitarian aid to them is very difficult. Only people outside these areas can reached by assistance. If a city like Maiduguri with a population of more than one million were to be attacked by the Boko Haram offensive, the result would be an extremely serious humanitarian disaster")

Cardinal Francis George OMI (wrote "...many Catholics in the American colonies thought their life might be better in the new country than under a regime whose ruling class had penalized and persecuted them since the mid-16th century. They made this new country their own and served her loyally. The social history was often contentious, but the State basically kept its promise to protect all religions and not become a rival to them, a fake church. Until recent years...Swimming against the tide means limiting one's access to positions of prestige and power in society. It means that those who choose to live by the Catholic faith will not be welcomed as political candidates to national office, will not sit on editorial boards of major newspapers, will not be at home on most university faculties, will not have successful careers as actors and entertainers. Nor will their children, who will also be suspect. Since all public institutions, no matter who owns or operates them, will be agents of the government and conform their activities to the demands of the official religion, the practice of medicine and law will become more difficult for faithful Catholics. It already means in some States that those who run businesses must conform their activities to the official religion or be fined...")
