Pakistan: Kot Radha Kishan, Kasur, Punjab province

Christian husband and wife accused of Quran desecration, attacked by a mob summoned with mosque loudspeakers, stripped naked, legs broken, tied to a tractor and dragged to a brick kiln and burnt alive, police were called but did nothing, nearly a dozen local Christian families fled the area, their remains were recovered from the brick kiln but were quickly buried rather than turned over to their family

Shahzad Masih (aged 28, husband of Shama Bibi, father of four aged 18 months to 7 years, **burnt alive**)

Shama Bibi (aged 25, wife of Shahzad Masih, expectant mother, mother of four aged 18 months to 7 years, **burnt alive**)

Parveen Bibi (sister-in-law of Shahzad Masih)

Yasmeen Bibi (sister of Shama Bibi, described the attack on her sister and brother-in-law "They beat them with wooden clubs on their heads, and hatchets, before they were both tied to a tractor and pulled out onto a road which was under construction, covered with crushed stones. I think they were unconscious, but still breathing, but the mob was still not willing to leave them alone. They took some petrol from a tractor and doused their bodies and threw them in the kiln. Then I lost hope and fled with my children from there...Some men asked them [the police who were present] to fire into the air to quell the protestors, because the mob had no weapons to fire back...Shama and her husband might have survived if the police had taken timely action")

Mukhar Masih (father of Shama Bibi, said "and I know tactics the government uses to oppress us...Last night when I left the village, it had been decided that the funeral would be held the next day. But instead it was hastily done at midnight, as if our children were thieves...My daughter Yasmeen is the eyewitness of the entire incident, but she is not included in the FIR [police report], so how can I know the state is committed to providing us justice?")

Poonam (aged 1, youngest daughter of Shama Bibi, pulled from her mother's arms and thrown on the floor when he mother was seized by the mob, orphaned after her parents were burned alive)

Salman (aged 5, son of Shahzad Masih and Shama Bibi, orphaned after his parents were burned alive)

Sonia (aged 3, daughter of Shahzad Masih and Shama Bibi, orphaned after her parents were burned alive)

Bishop Irfan Jamil (said that the perpetrators must be prosecuted)

Bryan Barkley (aged 71, dismissed from his 20 year volunteer position at the Red Cross for publicly opposing same-sex marriage)

United Kingdom: HMP Littlehey, Cambridgeshire

Rev Barry Trayhorn (prison gardener, volunteer prison chaplain, resigned from his gardening position after being harassed following a May 2014 homily, said "I simply said what the Bible says. Prisoners need to hear God's word just as much as anyone else. If people come to a Christian chapel service, we cannot hold back the gospel truth that God forgives those who repent. As I led the worship, I spoke about the wonder of God's love and the forgiveness that comes through Jesus Christ to those who recognize their sin and repent. I said that I am the worst sinner I know. But that wasn't politically correct. The mere mention of homosexual behavior in the Bible verses that I quoted provoked complaint. I was barred from taking part in chapel services and trouble came my way. I was put under enormous pressure for daring to say what the Bible says")

Andrea Minichiello Williams (Chief Executive of Christian Concerns; **UPDATE:** said on November 2, 2015 "It is astonishing that Barry was forced out of a sex offenders' prison for repeating what the Bible says about sexual behavior – during a chapel service – as he spoke about repentance and forgiveness. This is an important case. Freedom to maintain a clear gospel witness in prisons needs to be protected")

Christian school attacked by 200 Islamists from two madrasas [Islamic schools] due to rumors of forced conversions, students uninjured, 17 arrested including 3 madrasa teachers

Sumitra Kunda (aged 25, teacher, suffered a serious head injury)

Michael Robin Mondol (principal, hidden by the school staff from the Islamists who named him as a target, said "A wave of panic swept through the school and traumatized everyone. Many students became sick in the following days")

Sr Habiba (has been aiding 1,500 displaced Christians, described the October 20, 2014 flooding of the refugee camp "The tents quickly filled with water and collapsed. They were engulfed in mud. Some people had to be taken to the hospital. This happened at 3 a.m.")

Sr Ban (has been aiding 1,500 displaced Christians, said "What is this Islamic State [ISIL] that is frightening the world? More should be done to remove these militants who have caused great human suffering to our people")

government by spreading Christianity and sentenced to eight years in prison; **UPDATE:** mother has fled the country due to threats and intimidations)

Iraq: Erbil, Kurdistan

Soham Yakoub (refugee, said "Every moment is suffering. We can't sleep. It rained yesterday. The sound was like stones on the tent. My child said to me this morning he wants to go home. He told me we'll go back today. I asked him, 'how, did you dream this?' He stared at me, silently. I don't know, maybe he dreamt he went back to our house")

Asrar Walid (refugee, said "Life is very bad here when it rains. We've suffered a lot. There is no machine for washing. We don't have anything. We don't have money. We ask for help to leave Iraq. Everyone just sits watching us from a distance without going to much trouble to find out how bad things are for us. Water leaks into the tents. They won't protect us in winter")

Fadia Salem (refugee, said "We left our homes around Qaraqush. No one is there now, everyone left. If there'd been international protection for us, we wouldn't have left our homes, wouldn't have to live in these tents. But is there any international protection?")

Fr Douglas Bazi (**UPDATE:** said "When our history and our name and everything are obliterated, that really is a genocide. The groups who have suffered the most from what's happened in Mosul are our brothers the Yazidis and the Christians. I am not surprised if ISIL kills people of that religion. What a way to treat them, and those who have no religion!")

Pastor Karen Dunham (**UPDATE:** complained of municipal harassment of her church after she was ordered to remove a painted cross from a stone arch "I was told to remove graffiti because it was lowering the value of surrounding buildings, and I thought, 'You've gotta be kidding. My neighbor is building a third story [on an illegally constructed building], there's an illegal house sitting on my property, my fence is missing and he's giving me a ticket for a cross on my door?")

Danny Povolotski (spoke of a double standard in the persecution of Christians "If it was Jews, there would be choppers there and tanks. I really believe most of the indifference of the

police is because she's not a Jew, she's a Christian...It's almost like everyone is deaf. The level of brute force compared to the level of lack of response of the police force there is pretty shocking. To me it's pretty shocking how it looks like a massive corruption thing going on there.")

It is particularly disturbing to see how much Boko Haram continues to advance in Borno and Adamawa States, despite the significant deployment of military forces and security in those areas")

Vietnam: Ben Cat, Binh Duong province

A church issued a report on continuing persecution by police “They send gangs and thugs, strangers, masked people, and police of various units to harass and arrest us during the day and the night, when we worship, when we pray, when we have Bible study, when we have children’s classes, when we eat together, when we have school ceremonies. They use bricks and stones to damage our building, and they pelt us with rotten eggs...They employ police of the 113 unit, rapid response police, security police in plain clothes, gangs and thugs, all taking turns to harass and threaten us. Thirty-four people have been injured, some to the point they had to be taken to hospital emergency. Pastor Quang was attacked in the church sanctuary in June by a gang with police and officials looking on, not lifting a finger to intervene”

Pastor Nguyen Hong Quang (**UPDATE**: arrested along with his son, another pastor, and six other parishioners by police accompanied by provocatively dressed prostitutes, church ransacked, signed the persecution report after their release)

The police advised us to throw out unknown women who looked pregnant because the bombers hide bombs under false bellies")
