Kenya: Garissa

Garissa University College Islamic terror attack

Alex (aged 19, student, survived the terror attack)

Alfred Mutua (shot in the leg, survived)

Anderson Owalo (shot five times, survived)

Collins Wetangula (student, described the al-Shabab attack on Garissa University College in which Muslims were freed and 148 others mostly Christians were killed and 104 injured, said he and his roommates locked themselves in their dorm room, added "All I could hear were footsteps and gunshots. Nobody was screaming because they thought this would lead the gunmen to know where they are...If you were a Christian, you were shot on the spot. With each blast of the gun, I thought I was going to die")

Cynthia Cheroitich (aged 19, survived the al-Shabab terror attack, hid in a cabinet, prayed "make them to be blind so they cannot see me", a terrorist opened the cabinet, moved a bag that covered her head, and did not see her)

Daisy Onyango (aged 20, hid from the terrorists, survived)

Duncan Obwamu (aged 25, student, saw a woman leading Christian prayers shot dead at the beginning of the attack, said of the shooter "He didn't say anything, but you could see from the look on his face he was very happy. I heard him laugh as he communicated with the others outside. He was very happy about what he'd done", shot in the arm and shoulder, pretended to be dead)

Elias Magangi Nyangwono (aged 23, first year education major, escaped the terror attack, both roommates - Isaac Pop Bushen Kosgei and Gideon - were killed)

Esther Kawira (student, survived the terror attack, said "Bullets missed me narrowly as I fled for my life while the terrorists were separating Muslims from non-Muslims before gunning down the Christians")

Eva Chepkemoi (shot in the left leg, survived)

- Fred Kaskon Musinai (father of Garissa University student Elizabeth Namarome Musinai, called at 1 by an al-Shabab terrorist who said "I am going to kill your daughter", after gunshots were heard told him "She is now with her God")
- Frederick Gitonga (aged 21, student, survived the terror attack on Garissa University College because he had been up late praying with a classmate and missed the morning prayer meeting, hid under his bed)
- Grace Kai (student, said "Some strangers had been spotted in Garissa town and were suspected to be terrorists. Then on Monday our college principal told us that strangers had been spotted in our college. On Tuesday we were released to go home, and our college closed, but the campus remained in session, and now they have been attacked")
- Joel Ayora (said the terrorists first burst into a church service, seized worshippers, and "proceeded to the hostels, shooting anybody they came across except their fellows, the Muslims")
- Bishop Joseph Alessandro OFM Cap. (Maltese national, said "We woke up with the noise of helicopters flying low over the town and ambulance and police sirens blaring. We immediately understood that something serious happened...It is very sad that this attack is happening during the Easter festivities...Most of the students in the college are not from here, they are not Somali, and they are not Muslims")

Kaberia Muiti (shot twice in the back, survived)

Maureen Manyego (aged 21, heard al-Shabab terrorists tell students "We are not bad guys, we are just here to make your Easter Holiday better" before shooting them)

Mercy Chepkorir (shot in both legs, survived)

Millicent Murugi (student, survived the terror attack on Garissa University College, said "One terrorist picked up a call from a phone on a dead body close by, and he said that they were continuing to kill their children, and that they need to know that Garissa is for Muslims only")

Peter Njue (shot in the chest, stomach and left arm, survived)

Rachel Gikonyo (shot seven times in her stomach and chest, survived, cannot feel her legs due to spinal damage)

Reuben Mwavita (aged 21, student, saw three female students shot dead while they prayed)

Rose Nafula (mother of Elizabeth Namarome Musinai, in shock)

Susan Kitoko (aged 24, student, jumped from a window to escape the terrorists, hip broken)

- Amos Simiyu (first year student at Garissa University College, hid from the al-Shabab terrorists under a staircase where the thrown grenades were deflected by a wall, saw them retrieve ammunition from caches hidden in the dormitory, then use knives when they ran out of ammunition)
- Gideon Nyabwengi (aged 19, student, saw his best friend killed while begging for mercy during the April 2, 2015 attack on Garissa University College, said "When we went to that university, we thought what kind of university is this? The lack of security was a major

thing. When you got your letter of admission to Garissa some people were saying it wasn't safe to go. This thing was being predicted")

Stanley Muli (aged 22, student, hid in his wardrobe during the April 2, 2015 attack on Garissa University College, said "I was just praying [to] God that the [Kenya Defence Forces] would come. I was just thinking how come they have taken so long, because the barracks are near. The government failed to protect us. We are angry, because we lost some of our best friends. How come security wasn't there when we were at the university? They took no care")

Elsie Karemi (survived the Garissa University College Islamic terror attack, said "I heard gun shots at 5.50am and I managed to hide in the wardrobe for one and a half days. When I was rescued I found out my roommates did not survive. Because of my tiny wardrobe space, I was unable to walk for two weeks after that but I thank God for sparing my life")

Abwamu Duncan (survived the Garissa University College Islamic terror attack, shot in the arm then twice more as she pretended to be dead)

For the youngest, it was a special feast, for they carried the adorned candles during the procession...Faith is really stronger than fear")

Fr Raniero Cantalamessa OFM Cap. (Preacher to the Papal Household, said in a homily during the Passion of Our Lord "For once let us not think about social evils collectively: hunger, poverty, injustice, the exploitation of the weak. These evils are spoken about often [even if it is never enough], but there is the risk that they become abstractions — categories rather than persons. Let us think instead of the suffering of individuals, people with names and specific identities, of the tortures that are decided upon in cold blood and voluntarily inflicted at this very moment by human beings on other human beings, even on babies...How many instances of 'Ecce homo' ['Behold the man!'] there are in the world! How many prisoners who find themselves in the same situation as Jesus in Pilate's praetorium: alone, hand-cuffed, tortured, at the mercy of rough soldiers full of hate who engage in every kind of physical and psychological cruelty and who enjoy watching people suffer. Javed David (**UPDATE**: said "It was 8 o'clock in the evening when we left to return to Lahore. We were about to reach the main road when a motorbike drove up and blocked the way. Maybe they were following us. The two bikers were wearing a helmet. One of them came up to my window and spoke to me. 'We know what you are doing here,' he said. 'Stop building churches. Convert to Islam, which is the true religion. Otherwise we will make a horrible example of you", added "My family and I are scared and worried because I continue to receive threats. Where can we go to enjoy religious freedom? This is our country; we have lived here for generations. After the tragedy in Youhanabad, circumstances have changed and now there is more fear. Still, I dedicated my life to Christ and I shall continue to serve His people, no matter what happens")

Previously, when we bought land to build the church in Sheikhupura, we met resistance from some members of the local Muslim community, but then it all worked out. India: Makthal Mandhal village, Mahabubnagar district, Telangana state

Rev Christopher Meesaul (returned with his parishioners from an outdoor sunrise service to their church to find two Hindu nationalist flags flying inside it, took down the flags, Hindu nationalists later invaded the service, threw the flags into a sewer and photographed them, forced to end the service and forcibly taken to a Hindu temple, said that on the way "The extremists mob were walking both on my left and right sides, and some were walking behind me while they all mocked me, abused my faith in Christ, pushed and slapped me from both sides, and they kicked me from behind as well", rescued by police, added "Under the extremists' pressure, the police officials told me to move back the front side of the church from the road by three feet, and they told me to oblige and not to file any police complaint on the matter. I was compelled to do it")

As a result of the judge's decision, baby girls in the womb in Britain remain at risk...The judge has acted politically by refusing to order into evidence the footage that could have secured a conviction. He has taken sides with the

establishment, which wants to brush this hugely contentious issue under the carpet. He has allowed the CPS to get away with failing to do its job and used his power to impose a heavy penalty on a young woman who is passionate about justice...Hurdle after hurdle has been erected in this case")
