Iran

Naghmeh Shariat Panahi Abedini (wife of Saeed Abedini, who has been sentenced to eight years imprisonment; **UPDATE**: reacted to a White House statement that President Obama would likely veto any bill that conditioned relaxation of Iranian sanctions with her husband's release "Our government must not forget that Saeed is not being held by the reformists with whom they negotiate but by radical hardliners who oppose what he represents – a Christian convert and an U.S. citizen. We cannot leave my husband's fate in the hands of these radicals. I implore our government to remember the urgency of bringing Saeed home to our family")

Two Christians were sentenced to additional prison time for "action against national security through collusion and gathering", the gathering in question was a meeting where they met with a friend to say goodbye before the beginning of one's original prison term

Ebrahim Firouzi (convert, aged 30; rearrested on August 21, 2013 while visiting two other Christians in Karaj; **UPDATE**: sentenced to five additional years' imprisonment)

Sevada Aghasar (arrested on August 21, 2013 in the Karaj office of Masoud Mirzaei; released from prison in Tehran on March 2, 2014; **UPDATE**: sentenced to five additional years' imprisonment)

Archbishop Jacques Behnan Hindo (**UPDATE**: announced that ISIL has completely surrounded his city "We are going through a terrible time. The jihadists of the Islamic State attacked Hassakah for two days. They were warded off by the army and Kurdish militias. But we are cut off, like an island surrounded by jihadists from all sides...We have not had any news regarding the fate of 232 Assyrian hostages - among whom there are 51 children and 84 women - and initial contacts in an effort to secure their release have so far been unsuccessful")

Lebanon: Beirut

Jack Zayya (Syrian refugee, said "We are searching for the quickest way to go to Europe or Canada, maybe America...I had a car wash and, thank God, it provided for us for a long time. But it's all gone now - the house, our belongings, the car wash, everything...Kidnappings were about getting ransom from rich families or individuals at first. With Da'esh {ISIL}, though, there is no negotiating. We had to pay the jizya tax or die...Our children saw many beheadings. We were obligated to watch public executions. What kind of world is that for kids to grow up in? They were always scared")

Chorbishop Yatron Koliana (**UPDATE**: has pleaded with refugees to not leave, said "I'm telling them not to leave this land. This is our land. They say, 'OK - we're with you. This is our land, but what are we supposed to eat, dirt?"")

Pastor Zhang "Bike" Mingxuan (president of the Chinese Association of Christian Family Churches; **UPDATE**: said "One thing I'm sure of is that the authorities in Zhejiang are taking down crosses again, and they are doing it everywhere. From Ningbo to Lishui, they have begun to remove crosses. I believe the statement made by the central government that they will stop demolishing churches in Zhejiang is a lie. Local officials taking down Christian crosses is persecution of Christianity")

Sajan K George (**UPDATE**: said "the presence of many people is just an excuse to cancel. In fact, the government of Madhya Pradesh is not new at large scale religious events. In February 2011, almost 2 million people attended the Narmada Samajik Kumbh, a gathering organized by Hindu nationalist groups who openly engaged in hate propaganda against Christians")

Rami Fellemon (director of Jerusalem Evangelistic Outreach, described a mob attack on an Ethiopian Orthodox monastery that began after a dispute between a Christian and a Muslim "When they came, it was a wave of anger that was - you cannot describe it, you cannot understand it. Because when one kid is fighting with another kid, and 60 to 80

people come and start smashing doors and throwing stones on windows and doors of Christian families and smashing the cross of the convent, this is totally not about a kid hurting a kid. This is more about Islam and Christianity. It's more about persecution", the rioters spray-painted on the monastery the same slogans used by ISIL when beheading the Ethiopian refugees in Libya)

Nashat Filmon (Bible Society general director, "The dark ideology of ISIL is spreading all over the region like cancer. This is also including the Holy Land. Christians, overall, live here in peace and harmony with Muslims in Jerusalem and the West Bank, but incidents do happen from time to time, and it's true that these incidents have recently increased, especially in the Old City of Jerusalem...Pray for the relationships between Muslims and Christians to be good despite all of the problems. Pray that the Christians would act as they are called to be, 'salt and light' and a living testimony. Pray against this dark, satanic, and attacking spirit of fundamentalism, and for the Christians to respond in a way that reflects Christ")

And envy takes us when we see our Muslim brothers build mosques where they will, how they will, at any place and at any time! And the State helps them. But as for us, we cannot build anything and that which is already open is being closed...We, the Copts are citizens with rights and see Muslims get whatever they want, while we are always prevented...Copts are between a state anvil and aggressor hammer")

Pastor Zhang "Bike" Mingxuan (president of the Chinese Association of Christian Family Churches; **UPDATE**: said "I called Pastor Wu Changle [on May 7, 2015], and the police listened to the phone call. The next day, six domestic security protection squad [DSPS] agents from the Suqian Municipal Public Security Bureau threatened Pastor Wu, saying that he must not welcome me")

Pastor Wu Changle (said "They [DSPS agents] came to my house and said they knew [Pastor] Zhang had contacted me and planned on coming to visit. They asked if I wanted him to visit and said the Chinese House Church Alliance has been banned. They said that if he comes to my home, I should just tell him I'm not there. I said Christians cannot tell lies. I'm home, and he wants to visit me because we haven't seen each other in a long time. Why would I lie to him? The police said if I really want to see him, I can do so, but we can't go to a gathering. They also said if I decide to welcome him, I should notify the DSPS that Zhang is coming and when")

The current ordained ministers gathered around the candidates, laying hands on them and commissioning them for the work ahead. All this is part of the EYN and Church of the Brethren plan to strengthen the church in Nigeria")

Rev Stanley J Noffsinger (general secretary Church of the Brethren USA, said "the attendees had a sort of shocked expression on their faces. The proceedings were constantly being

interrupted by announcements of tragedy – news of a pastor being killed or abducted, or a village being overrun by the terrorist group Boko Haram")

Rev Samuel Dante Dali (husband of Dr Rebecca Dali; **UPDATE**: said that 1,290 churches out of 2,280 had been destroyed with over 700,000 church members displaced since 2009, and has begun to construct 'rescue centers aka Brethren villages' to resettle church members, added "The peace heritage of the church is still the only way consistent with the gospel that we uphold")

Archbishop Martin Kivuva Musonde (said "Some say God has left us. Some ask has God abandoned Kenya? We have been the pride of Africa for many years. We have been known for our political maturity, as a business hub and center for tourism, but this has now been washed away by terror and banditry")

Archbishop Eliud Wabukala (**UPDATE**: condemned "the culture of short memory, where noise is made after every attack only to be followed by studious silence, we hear of arrests and people being taken to court but never the conclusion of the cases")

Sonia Gandhi (widow of Rajiv Gandhi, opposition Congress party leader, threatened with "direct action" by Hindu radicals if she dedicated the orphanage)

Rev Ramesh Chandekar (church attacked, crucifix, holy vessels, and microphone damaged or destroyed)

Anita Benjamin (met with the state Home Minister to describe the Hindu attack on the church)

Pastor Roderick Gilbert (met with the state Home Minister to describe the Hindu attack on the church)

Pastor V Joseph (said that police stood at the gate and allowed the attackers to storm the church and later arrested Christians "They kept hitting us, alleging that we were involved in religious conversion and fake healings...Police, even after knowing our innocence

registered a case against us", later met with the state Home Minister to describe a Hindu attack on their church)

Sajan K George (UPDATE: said "religious freedom is on a downward spiral" in India)

India: Pipaldhar, Khandwa district, Madhya Pradesh state

Sr Jaya OAS (described an attack of a center for mentally disabled children "It was 3:15 am Tuesday. Everyone was asleep, when suddenly heavy bricks were thrown on the roof of the house and fell into the room where we [four nuns] slept. Thanks to the Lord's Divine Providence, no one was injured and the children were not present at that time. Now we sisters are afraid")

Bishop Chacko Thottumarickal (said after the attack on a home for disabled children "Fundamentalists seem to have a feeling that they can do anything and get away with it")

Sajan K George (**UPDATE**: said "This is an attack not only against the sisters but also against children, those with more difficulties. All this makes the misdeed worse. The attack is an affront against society itself, to which the women religious offer a tireless and generous service by caring for needy children. The sisters re-educate children that society marginalizes. The authors of the crime show a lack of morality. Their night-time raid reflects the darkness of their minds and hearts")
