A large extended family has been allowed to return home after being forced out of their village on May 24, 2015 after a Facebook account in one son's name had cartoons of Muhammad posted to it, that son is illiterate and had no Facebook page, crops and cattle destroyed, the Muslim governor publicly defended the family from collective punishment and personally welcomed them home

Three church leaders were taken into custody on the 26th anniversary of the Tiananmen Square crackdown, released late in the evening

China: Shekou Development Zone, Guangdong province

Zhang (member of a church on the grounds of an international school, said "Under political pressure and other pressures, the gate keepers and security guards at Shekou International School have been persecuting the church, requiring the church to issue passes to everyone who comes for worship. Only those who have their passes are allowed to enter the church and participate in the worship service. Those without a pass are not allowed in...We study the Bible and we know that churches that believe in Jesus Christ are open to everyone, especially to those who are devout followers of our Lord. Restrictions should not be imposed for any reason to prevent people from coming to church to attend a worship service", the lease on the church building has not been renewed)
