[Muslim Syrian refugees] wake me before dawn during Ramadan and say that I should eat before the sun comes up. If I refuse, they say, I'm a kuffar, an unbeliever. They spit at me. They treat me like an animal. And threaten to kill me", the Security Service would not help him because "They are also all Muslims")

Sameeha Ayad (wife of Talaat Ayad, mother of Youssef Talaat Ayad and Ishak, beaten by a Muslim mob that invaded his home, required 5 stitches in her head)

Emad (cousin of Amgad Emad Zikry, beaten by a mob of 200 Muslims, skull and leg fractured) Fr Istaphanos Shehata (described the attack)

Fr Sarophim (described the attack "After the victims arrived at the hospital the police and someone from the District Attorney's office came to take their statements as a standard procedure. But no arrest warrant was issued, even though the criminals are known to everybody. As usual the police dealt with the situation with apathy")

Archbishop Jacques Behnan Hindo (**UPDATE**: said "Moscow's intervention has been positive because they are really targeting ISIL and the militia are beginning to flee. They fled from the area in about 20 cars in a hurry in the direction of Iraq, leaving another 20 cars on site...On the night of Feb. 23, when ISIL attacked, the American planes flew over the area for a long time without intervening. Then for three days we saw no more jets, leaving the field open to the militants. This makes us think that in some way have been helped by the Americans and their ambiguous attitude...They [ISIL] have executed three [Christians] and they are preparing another three for an upcoming execution...People [in Deir ez-Zor] are dying of hunger, they lack food and medicine. Just think that today 50 kg of sugar costs as much as a car or a house. People sell the car to buy it. The ISIL has imposed a real blockade, men, women, elderly and children are starving")

I would answer, 'I am a Nazarene, i.e. a Christian'. At that point, they would shout, 'Then you're an infidel. And since you are an infidel, if you do not convert, we are going to cut your throat with a knife'. But I never signed a statement to renounce Christianity...Whilst I was a prisoner, I was waiting for the day of my death but with great inner peace. I had no problem with dying in the name of our Lord. I would not be the first nor the last, but one among the thousands of martyrs for Christ")

- Pastor Anil Kumar (hit on the head with a bucket, suffered a deep cut, later said "Balanagar is [a] stronghold for the RSS and all its affiliates. It is becoming increasingly difficult to hold prayers in Christian homes. Even the Christians are afraid of hosting prayers in their homes")
- Pastor David (Independent Church, said "This is a cruel act carried out in the name of Hindu nationalism. Fringe Hindu radicals portray Christians as anti-nationals so innocent Christians are punished for no wrong doing")
- Rev Ronald John (President of the Telangana Christian Joint Action Committee, said "This is a highly condemnable act and the perpetrators should be punished under the law. The Christian community across the Mahabubnagar district are deeply distressed")

Thanks also to other members of the faithful who live nearby and rushed to the scene to assess the damage and tidy up the church and this enabled us to celebrate our daily morning Mass here today")

Fr Ibrahim Alsabagh OFM (**UPDATE**: described the artillery attack on his church "Just at that moment I was preparing to administer the Eucharist to the faithful. Suddenly everything began to shake, and all kinds of debris fell down inside the church. There was so much dust that we couldn't see one another. If it had blown a hole through the dome, it could have been a tragedy. And even if it had only caused the chandelier to fall, it could have killed as many as ten people. As I said to my congregation, it was the mantle of the Blessed Virgin that protected us...It certainly wasn't any accident that the attack took place during the Sunday evening Mass, when there were 400 people inside the church", after determining that there were no serious injuries he continued the Mass: "Some of

them were astonished by my reaction. But it is in the Lord that we find our strength, in union with Him through prayer", said that the next day the people returned for Mass: "There were so many of them, and we joyfully listened once again to the sound of our bells")
