China: Hangzhou, Zhejiang province

Zan Aizong (writer, **UPDATE**: detained by National Security Bureau officers, released, wrote "Please ask for the Lord's mercy. Today, I was accused on suspicion of subverting national security, and my cell phone, computer, etc., were confiscated. After this matter

was recorded, I was free to go home for the time being, but I cannot speak and I cannot post on WeChat again. Currently, I can only write papers on technology to make my living...I would like to thank Jesus Christ for his grace and help and I would also like to thank the police officers, of whom there were over 10, who came to my home to search it for many hours. Because of the Lord, I do not have any hatred towards any person, nor do I have an enemy. Because the Bible says God is love, I love all the people in the world. I will not be able to use WeChat often, and can only be reached by email now")

China: Yulin, Shaanxi province

Gao Zhisheng (aged 51, Christian human rights attorney, released from prison on August 7, 2014, detained on September 24, 2015 after accounts of torture while in prison became public, released but under house arrest; UPDATE: has been denied access to a dentist due to fears evidence of torture will be documented, wrote "...there is no understanding [by the authorities], just repeating over and over that they are 'the world's second largest superpower', and adding that they have a 'responsible behavioral style'. When, just a short while ago, a common person's teeth are destroyed and lost, [the attempt to correct the damage] is deemed a matter of 'national security'...the outside world can speculate that because I cannot treat my teeth, I must always be in a mood of personal, bitter hardship and torture. This is not entirely true. The world I find inside books occupies me to the point that I forget to eat. I do not even have the leisure to negotiate [with the police] regarding my suffering. To me, it is incredibly precious that I now have books to read. Generally speaking, I know I will disappear immediately again after my book is published. So I am determined to try my best to read more books. This is something I need to do before this happens. This is very crucial to me")

Fr Stanislaus Jebamalai SJ (reported to have organized a petition which denounced "well-orchestrated efforts" by Hindu extremists to use the government against non-Hindus, said "A very dangerous trend is gaining momentum in the country, which tolerates violence against minorities of all kinds...It is coming to you, it will be too late if you wait till it comes to you")

India: Thomas Nagar, Tamil Nadu state

Two Christians were beaten by drunken policemen who said "What has Jesus done for you, sons of prostitutes? Why are you running to Him?", the police seized their vehicle documentation and charged them with lacking documentation

The 'full, physical destruction of the enemy' [as a colleague described it aptly] is the goal that will be achieved")

Fr Moses Otii Alir MCCI (described the October 30, 2015 rioting that began with the murder of three Muslims "On their way to the parish, they started looting and burning all the houses and shops. They gathered in front of the parish gate, wanting to destroy the church and butcher all of us...The shootings and the burning of houses lasted almost 10 hours", one UN peacekeeper protecting the church was wounded; UPDATE: wrote that the neighborhood was still "in the hands of the assailants. It is very difficult to get out of the parish compound. The situation does not seem to be getting better. We do not know what could happen from one moment to the next")

Fr Luka Awad (assistant to Archbishop Selwanos Boutros Alnemeh, said "When the ISIL fighters conquered Al-Qaryatayn, they made the threat: 'We will kill all of the Christians in Sadad'...The people there still speak Aramaic, the language of Jesus. Moreover, we have important churches there. It is really a center of our Christian heritage. Its loss doesn't bear contemplating. We truly are fearing for our cultural heritage. We beg the international community to put an end to this war. My people already experienced a genocide one hundred years ago, in 1915. Now, in the 21st century, we don't need another")

Some nearby villagers have gone to sleep at churches in Mohnyin town, as they fear random attacks by the Burma Army...I feel like they intentionally launched the attacks on the day when Christians held worship...As soon as we heard civilians fled for safety [to Mohnyin], we held prayer and pray to God to protect them. We are weak, and what we can do is keep praying and relying on God. We believe that God is capable to protect our people")

They tended to us and helped us recover, however we have all been badly traumatized and have not yet been back to work. We hope to start back on Monday if our employers have not already given our work away. The police officers have not yet returned our money and we do not know if we will ever get our wages back. We are already poor but this attack destroys our already hard to manage finances. I have seven children, two daughters and five sons. Two of my sons work with me in the brick kilns to feed our family, none of my children ever went to school as we could not afford it. Our lives have been worthless but we thank God for them even then")

It is the fatal end of apostolic Christianity in a Biblical Land which becomes a hostage of violence and intolerance in the name of a radical faith that neither supports pluralism nor accepts differences...The Christians of the East face an almost suicidal choice. Living under the shadow of Islam remains a choice quite difficult to assume. Living in the shadow of Islam requires a return to the early centuries of the Church, which highlights the hidden life of Jesus in Nazareth")

Archbishop Matthew Hassah Kukah (UPDATE: spoke on the origins of Boko Haram "A hypocritical elite continues to believe that it can claim the benefits of democracy but use it only to consolidate its hold on power. This is what has laid the foundation for what is now Boko Haram...We must locate the current crisis of Boko Haram within the context of the inability of the northern Muslim elite to live by their own dubious creed of being Muslims. They preached Sharia Law but only for the poor. They preach a religion that encourages education, yet their own people are held in the bondage of ignorance. They did not wish to live by the same standards, so they decided to live their own Islam in the capitals of the world away from the prying eyes of their own people. Boko Haram began as a revolt against this mendacity, subterfuge and hypocrisy. Now, I hear Muslims in northern Nigeria hiding under the cover of the facts by saying: 'These Boko Haram people are not Muslims. They do not represent us'. Well, first, they are your own children. You must take responsibility for what has made them what they are today and to the rest of society. They claim they have been inspired by the Quran and no other holy book. They say they want to build an Islamic state. So, they are Muslims. After all, from the debates of the Constituent Assemblies of 1979, 1988, and 1995 and beyond, did their fathers and grandfathers not stage walkouts, demanding Sharia Law? The promise to institute Sharia has become the most potent tool for political mobilization and organization. Till date, the tactics may have changed, but the essence has not. Rather than face the tough questions of how and why over 15 million children in the northern states are on the streets; how and why the northern states are falling behind on almost every index of development, the northern Muslim elite continues to live for just the moment, with no plans for tomorrow...Should we pretend that a society that allows the forced marriages of its young daughters could frown on the idea of a group kidnapping and forcing young girls into sexual slavery? Islam must have an honest look at the mirror and have an internal discussion...It is my considered view that northern Islam has to confront the realities of taking its religion into the modern world of democracy seriously. Muslims in northern Nigeria cannot accept democracy and reject the inclusive nature of its philosophy as it is the case today")
