Rev John Joseph Hayab (reported on the murder of Bridget Patience Agbahime, "We got it on good authority that the slain woman never blasphemed the prophet Muhammad, that the mastermind of the killing was fond of always provoking the [now] deceased and so, on

that fateful day, we learned, the said man was doing ablution in front of the woman's shop and was cautioned – that was all. The man raised the alarm that she blasphemed prophet Muhammad. The man deliberately provoked the woman in question just to carry out that gruesome and barbaric act. All those that perpetuated the killing of the innocent woman must be fished out and brought to book")

## Christians were violently prevented from voting

Fr Albert Thomas Rozario (**UPDATE**: described the attack "There are 1,800 Catholic voters out of a total of 2,400, but none of them were able to vote due to violence and fear. Most of the 700 people who went to vote in the morning returned home without casting their vote because the attackers pounded on them")

Jonas Costa (aged 48, council member, said "I was 100 percent sure about re-election but I have been forced into defeat, but I don't accept it. We will go to court to challenge the result and demand a new election")

Bilash B Gomes (filed a police report)

Ronel Gomes (aged 23, said "They attacked me in the polling center and I rushed to my home, but they chased me and beat me at home. They threatened to kill me if I voted. We are living in fear because a legal case has now been filed. If justice is not delivered it would be tough for us to live in this area", left hand fractured)

Pastor Meera Rani (beaten by 25 members of the ABVP [the student wing of the BJP Hindu nationalist political party] during a church service, one of her fingers was fractured and her neck was cut under the ear)

Arun Kumar (described the attack "The church service was disrupted by members of the ABVP disguised as students. They stormed the venue, created a disturbance and proceeded to beat the Christians present using their belts. They also pelted stones at the women and children present...Many of the Christians were seriously injured and had to be admitted to the local hospital for treatment and first aid...The ABVP people have warned the Christians not to conduct any more worship services in the church or else next Sunday they will come with guns and swords and will kill the Christians and cut them to pieces")

Pastor Li Guozhi aka Yang Hua (husband of Wang Hongwu; formally charged on January 22, 2016 with 'obstructing justice' and 'gathering a crowd to disturb social order'; UPDATE: wrote to his wife from jail "It must be the result of everyone's prayers that my lower back pain is no longer an issue. I sleep soundly at night. Don't worry. I've adjusted to other aspects of life well. As the Book of Isaiah says, 'In repentance and rest is your salvation, in quietness and trust is your strength' [Isaiah 30:15]. It's also a kind of rest, staying inside... You shouldn't be too anxious. It is best to remain peaceful and wait for God. God is omniscient. I believe that he never makes a mistake. If it is convenient, please send me a [recent] picture of you and our sons. Let's pray and leave other things to God. Thank you for investing everything in this family. I am grateful for what God has given me; let's carry the cross and hasten down the road to heaven, until the day we meet the Lord...Always be happy and peaceful. Never stop praying. Be grateful, because that's God's will conveyed through Jesus Christ...Amen! Emanuel!")

Maryam Naghash-Zargaran aka Nasim (aged 38, began serving four years imprisonment on July 15, 2013, apparently has had a heart attack in prison, transferred to Modares hospital on September 29, 2013, condition unknown; subjected to an extremely invasive and public strip search upon returning to prison on November 12, 2014 after a four day furlough, health has been precarious; granted a leave for medical treatment on October 27, 2015, forced to return to prison on October 27, 2015 midway through her treatment; as of May 21, 2016 has continued to endure significant medical problems in prison, currently has nausea and pain in her ear, has been told to not move her head for two weeks, may require surgery, also suffers from spinal pain; as of May 27, 2016 has begun a hunger strike in an attempt to force prison authorities to give her proper medical treatment, is said to be nearly comatose; **UPDATE**: has been granted a medical leave, hospitalized)

## Pakistan: Bugri village, Kasur district, Punjab province

Manzoor Masih (aged 50, father of 10, home invaded by neighbors, after he disputed his payment for crops grown by his family, beaten, shot in the hand, clothes torn on female family members, home set afire, no arrests made, said "About six months ago my family and I labored in the fields...They [my neighbors] divided the profit among themselves and refused to give me my due - 26,000 rupees [roughly US\$260]. Whenever I demanded it they beat me up. On June 15, they again beat me, after which I informed the police...That night around 2am, around 15 men, armed with axes, batons and firearms, scaled the boundary wall and entered our house, calling us names, and saying they had been insulted in the village on our behalf. They fired one shot in the air and another into my left hand. Then they beat my wife and daughters, and humiliated them by touching their private parts...The police arrived and saw us all injured and bruised, but they were still not willing to register a case. This only became possible after several Christians from Lahore

arrived and pressurized the police", threatened with blasphemy charges if he pursues prosecution)

M C (said "I was inside with my children, my husband, my brother-in-law and my brothers [on a Sunday in June 2016]. They broke the windows and entered, firing their guns into the air, and then they threw us out. Then they came after us with large guns, machine guns, and

they were wearing masks. They told us to leave or they would set us on fire as well – the children and all")
