Friday December 1, 2017



India

Archbishop Thomas Ignatius Macwan (issued a letter on November 24, 2017 to various communities regarding the upcoming elections: "The forthcoming legislative elections in the state of Gujarat will affect the future of our country. We are aware that the secular and democratic fabric of our country is at stake, where human rights are violated and constitutional rights trampled. There are episodes in which churches are attacked, ecclesiastical staff, faithful or institutions are affected. There is growing sense of insecurity among minorities. Nationalist forces are about to conquer the country. The election results of the State Assembly of Gujarat can make a difference...The Bishops of the State of Gujarat invite you to organize prayer liturgies in your parishes and convents, hoping that the people who are elected will remain faithful to our Indian constitution and respect every human being without any discrimination"; accused of generating "fear" in his letter, accused on November 25, 2017 of violating the Model Code of Conduct in a complaint filed with the state Election Commission; **UPDATE**: denied internet rumors that he had been arrested for his letter, said "They served me notice on the 25th and I responded on the 27th. There has been no response after that. I hope the issue is over now")

- Samson Christian (said "...this is the first time the Hindu nationalists are targeting the church leader to polarize the Hindu voters...Archbishop Macwan has all the right to protect the people and ask them to pray. The complaint against the archbishop is politically motivated")
- K P George SJ (said "I fully support the concerns raised by Archbishop Thomas Macwan...If every party and every leader can ask his/her followers to vote for a particular person/party, why should that right be denied to the archbishop and for his members?")
- Virginia Saldanha (**UPDATE**: said "What the archbishop did is absolutely right. In no way is it campaigning or alignment with anyone. It only shows the caliber of the [Hindu nationalist] BJP and its nervousness about the elections")
- Fr Dominic Emmanuel (**UPDATE**: spoke after the only Catholic cabinet minister denied that Christians had been attacked under Prime Minister Modi "K.J. Alphons has to learn to tell lies like his masters Modi and Amit Shah [the BJP president]...Don't be surprised if

K.J. Alphons, to remain on his ministerial seat, will tomorrow repeat...[the] statement that Mother Teresa's work was all a facade for conversion")

Nigeria

Lois Haruna (aged 16, abducted in Markarfi, Kaduna state in September 2017, forcibly converted to Islam; **UPDATE**: released)

Nigeria: Gwoza, Borno state

Esther (aged 17 in 2015, alias, reported to have been abducted by Boko Haram militants in October 2015, father killed; rescued by the Nigerian military in November 2016, returned home; UPDATE: said "I cannot count how many men raped me. Every time they came back from their attacks, they would rape us...defile us. Each passing day, I hated myself more and more. I felt that God had forsaken me. There were times when I was so angry with God...But still I could not get myself to renounce Him. I found myself remembering His promise to never leave me or forsake me", after her return gave birth to a daughter, added "They mocked me because I was pregnant. Even my grandparents despised me and called me names. I cried many tears. I felt so lonely. What broke my heart even more was that they refused to call my daughter Rebecca. They referred to her as 'Boko'", said she has forgiven her abductors)

United Kingdom

Christians responded to year-old retweeted comments by a Scottish clergyman that called on people to pray that 4 year old Prince George would grow up to be homosexual and become King while in a same sex marriage

Bishop Gavin Ashenden (**UPDATE**: said "If you're going to pray for Prince George, pray for him to be happy...and pray for him to discharge his duty as prince, to be married and have children. It is not a kind prayer. It is not a blessing, it's more like a curse from a fairytale. I would say it is profoundly un-Christian...To use prayer as a mechanism for wishing this on Prince is an unkind and destructive thing to do. It doesn't have the prince's best interest at heart, but uses him as a gender-political football to please 1.7% of the population. What is especially odd and incongruous is the fact that it is suddenly OK to pray for someone to be gay, but totally unacceptable to pray for them to be free from being gay and to resume a sexuality that was in tune with their biology. This seems not only contradictory but hypocritical")

Susie Leafe (director of Reform, said "I was very disappointed that he [the Scottish clergyman] was prepared to bring a child in to this same-sex marriage debate. As a Christian minister he should pray for all people to come to know the love of Christ, rather than a fine young gentleman")

Bangladesh: Syleth

Fr Walter William Rozario (aged 41, assistant pastor, secondary school headmaster, brother of Premol Rozario, disappeared in Bonpara on November 27, 2017, ransom demanded; **UPDATE**: recovered by police, has suffered psychological trauma and has difficulty speaking, held in custody, accused by police of being mentally ill and of having staged his disappearance, later released from custody)

Fr Subroto Purification (**UPDATE**: criticized the "absurd conference held by the police" and added "We are literally without words. What the police say does not stand up. Why would William have to do this? We were organizing the pilgrimage of the faithful to Dhaka, and he too could not wait to meet the Pope. The staging is an unfounded hypothesis, as well as the mental illness. We do not know what it is based on and we hope everything can be clarified in court")

Pakistan: Charman, Baluchistan

Issac 'Lucky' Saleem (aged 7, son of Asalam and Noreen Masih, killed along with 2 others by a car bomb outside the main gate of a Christian colony [ghetto])

Khan Masih (aged 4, cousin of Issac 'Lucky' Saleem, son of Vickram and Nasreen, wounded, hospitalized, underwent surgery on his head, back, and left leg, released 4 days later)

Asalam Masih (aged 54, father of Issac 'Lucky' Saleem)

Noreen Masih (aged 48, mother of Issac 'Lucky' Saleem, said "My heart has been broken in two. My husband and I waited many years for the birth of my son and in a moment these cruel murderers have killed him and taken away my joy. They care nothing for the pain I feel. Their only desire was to murder Christians...Men in uniforms from the army and police and politicians have told me how they feel my pain, but we receive no help, nor no news of the capture of the murders. I want to ask them to their faces why they have taken the life of an innocent boy...I find it hard to sleep now, I feel old and weary, I pray to God that he will take me to heaven soon so that I can be reunited with Isaac. I cry and cry but the tears do not bring Isaac back or ease my pain")

Martha Madami (aged 50, wife of Madami Agiya, mother of Suzie Madami, Eli Madami and Hassan Madami, abducted by Fulani Muslims in Kwanti village on November 21, 2017; **UPDATE**: released, ransom of US\$13,770 paid)

Chili (aged 22, niece of Madami Agiya and Martha Madami, abducted by Fulani Muslims in Kwanti village on November 21, 2017; **UPDATE**: released, ransom paid)

Nigeria: Numan local government Area, Adamawa state

Pwanedo Justin (fled his home during a Fulani Muslim attack that killed 2 village headmen, said: "I watched helplessly as the Fulani herdsmen killed people and burnt houses. They did this with glee on their faces. Numan and its environs belong to us. If the government cannot protect us, then we have no choice but to protect our land, our heritage and the territory of our ancestors. That is all we have to hand on to our children")

Philippines: San Leonardo town, Nueva Ecija province, Luzon

Fr Marcelito "Tito" Paez (aged 72, officially retired but still active in ministry, shot while driving in traffic by four gunmen on motorcycles, died in the hospital)

Bishop Roberto Mallari (called the shooting death of Fr Marcelito "Tito" Paez an execution)

Sr Elenita Belardo (said "The execution is a brutal act that aims to sow terror among those who oppose the militaristic and despotic nature of Duterte's government and to silence those who continue to denounce extrajudicial executions and violations of human rights")

Fr Oliver Castor CSSR (said that the government's extrajudicial killing of drug dealers and addicts has begun to expand to political dissidents "It is systematic killing directed towards a specific section of the population. The year past, the targets were drug users, this time, leftists...[It] is chillingly reminiscent of the years of Marcos martial rule")

Teymur Sultan ogly Akhmedov (aged 61, husband, father of three sons, arrested on January 18, 2017 for sharing his religious beliefs with KNB secret police informants, held in pre-trial detention, denied cancer treatment; motion to terminate his case denied on March 1.

2017, reportedly has been beaten in prison, can barely walk; sentenced on May 2, 2017 to 5 years' imprisonment followed by 3 years' prohibition on preaching; appeal denied on June 20, 2017; **UPDATE**: Supreme Court appeal denied, still denied medical treatment)

Nigeria: Dong village, Numan local government Area, Adamawa state

Dabang Kayako (village head, killed by Fulani Muslim herdsmen)

Dawson K Tufano (retired court judge, spoke on a Muslim attack on his village "As we got early information of the Fulanis' imminent attack, we alerted the authorities, who responded by sending mobile policemen to secure the area. But before the arrival of the attackers, the security forces withdrew from the area, with no reason, paving the way for to the Fulani herdsmen. While our local vigilantes were in a fierce battle with the herdsmen, aircraft came from nowhere and started throwing bombs on our villages, abetting the herdsmen to kill several people, while many others were injured as houses and properties were completely razed due to the Air Force bombings...The whole thing was a calculated attempt to destroy us. If not, then why is it that the Air Force were only bombarding our people, while leaving alone the large number of well-armed herdsmen, who were twice the number of our population? Where I was hiding during the attack, I saw the herdsmen carrying sophisticated weapons, which I believed these herdsmen could not afford. We are now living in fear. At every loud sound, our people will start running, thinking that the herdsmen have returned to fulfil their promise to kill the survivors")

Nigeria: Lawuro village, Numan local government Area, Adamawa state

Ferdinand Boro (village head, killed by Fulani Muslim herdsmen)

Nigeria: Shaforon village, Numan local government Area, Adamawa state

Audu (husband of Hanatu Soloman, father of five, injured in a bombing of his village by the Air Force, hospitalized, died three days later)

Hanatu Soloman (aged 46, widow of Audu, mother of five, said "A good man was just killed like that, without anything done to his killers...When will the killing stop? It is either Boko Haram insurgents or herdsmen killing our people, [who] are mostly Christians. Many Christian women have lost their husbands. Our children cannot go to school again when our husbands, the bread winners, have been massacred. Most Christian women are raped by herdsmen when they launch an attack on their villages. Some women feel they must hide out of disgrace; other women become pregnant from these murderers")

Pastor Jean-Eric Vogbia (convert, church and home in the PK5 neighborhood of Bangui destroyed by Seleka rebels on December 5, 2013, eldest son [a medical student] killed, later said "We tried to contact him on the phone, but he was not reachable. At about 12 noon, my phone rang again and a voice said: 'The boy was killed. We didn't plan it, but as we missed you, we had to kill him'"; UPDATE: wife has suffered from PTSD, said "What happened was a punitive act because of my Muslim background. They wanted to silence the preacher who converts Muslims to Christianity...Each time I pass by the ruins of our family compound, now invaded by wild plants, I feel bad. But I need to overcome my anger and act with love towards my Muslim brothers and friends")

Pastor Gilbert Bogolo (husband, father of ten, petroleum company employee, church and home in Bangui destroyed by Seleka rebels on December 5, 2013; UPDATE: said "Maybe one day we will understand why [God] allowed us to go through this painful experience", said his parishioners now meet in a tent "It's not the big attendance of the old days, but the remaining members are more committed than ever. The donations we receive on Sundays are greater than ever")

Wednesday December 6, 2017



India

Bishop Vincent Barwa (**UPDATE**: criticized a call by Hindu radicals to enact the death penalty for cow slaughter)

India: Tarra village, Ranjim, Gariaband district, Chhattisgarh state

RSS paramilitary members attacked a prayer meeting attended by 600 Christians, men were beaten, women molested, automobiles and bicycles vandalized

Rev Lakhchan Sahu (aged 34, husband, father of two; said the Hindu extremists set up a sound system outside the prayer hall "They shouted from the mike, name-calling me a butcher, low-caste and much more, using all kinds of vulgar language. They said that they will carry their flag in one hand and a sword in the other and kill all those who dared to enter the prayer hall...While breaking the chairs, they threw the chairs on some worshippers who tried to stop them, causing them minor injuries. But before they could reach the main hall and attack the worshippers sitting inside, the police arrived")

Arun Pannalal (president of Chhattisgarh Christian Forum; **UPDATE**: said "There are no second- or third-generation Christians found in the area. As soon as a new church is established, they are intensely persecuted, and the church gradually dies down")

Shibu Thomas (founder of Persecution Relief; **UPDATE**: said "Christians had completed 200 days of prayer under the leadership of Rev Lakhchan Sahu. At around noon, more than a thousand people from the RSS and Bajrang Dal [youth organization] stormed the prayer venue")

Iraq: Bahzani

Christians were reported as needing protection to stay in their homes

Fr Afram al-Khoury Benyamen (said "The reality is we cannot stay without the U.S. or the UN helping to protect Nineveh directly. With international protection maybe we can remain, but if it doesn't come soon...we go...ISIL is not finished in Mosul and still they can come straight here. We expect more attacks. It is like staring into the darkness...Before ISIL, everything was green. Now everything is finished, nobody gave the olive trees water.

And when I see the village like this I feel there is no life here. We used to have 150 doves come to our church, too. But after ISIL, even they have not come back")

Mariam Ishaq (aged 58, said "There is no stability. Our homes are destroyed. I don't want to leave," Ishaq said. "But what else can we do?")

Faiza Yaaqoub (aged 68)

Deacon Benian Abdullah (said "We are always worried about who will be our future government? Who will be the next to control us?")

Rimon (aged 33, son of Silvia, died of untreated cancer in February 2017)

Silvia (mother of Rimon, said "Because of this crisis we could not find him medicine. We could not get help for him to leave. And so he lost his life")

Mulangira Ibrahim (aged 27, convert, former Islamic teacher, converted after being temporarily struck blind on October 4, 2015 when he attempted to question a Christian pastor regarding a vision of his conversion, beaten that day by local Muslims; ambushed near a church on November 16, 2017 and beaten, treated at a clinic; **UPDATE**: suffocated by an intruder in his home, hospitalized with chest and abdominal pain)

United Kingdom

Jacob Rees-Mogg (aged 48, Member of Parliament; **UPDATE**: wrote "One of the Conservative Party's clearest manifesto commitments was to lift the cap on places for Catholics at new schools. It said 'we will replace the unfair and ineffective inclusivity rules that prevent the establishment of new Roman Catholic schools, instead requiring new faith schools to prove that parents of other faiths and none would be prepared to send their children to that school'. There is no wriggle room in that sentence – yet the Department for Education, instead of implementing the policy decision, has decided to have an enquiry to decide whether to do what was promised or not...The problem with the current rules is that they limit the number of places for Catholics in new schools to 50 per cent if other, non-Catholics, wish to attend. This policy was not introduced with Catholic schools particularly in mind, but has a greater impact on them because, unlike some religious schools which attract virtually no one from outside their own community, Catholic schools are popular with non-Catholics...However, under Canon law Catholic bishops have certain obligations which mean that places cannot be preferentially offered to non-Catholics at the exclusion of Catholics")

Daniel Courney (aged 33, U.S. citizen, convicted on September 14, 2017 for use of 'threatening and discriminatory language' while street preaching; **UPDATE**: conviction overturned on appeal)

This has actually made me and my family stronger in faith... We did not do anything wrong, we just wanted to celebrate Christmas and distribute some goods to the poor")

Wilson Chowdhry (**UPDATE**: called police after a Christmas display hosted by nine local churches in a shopping district was interrupted by an unauthorized Islamic display that used loudspeakers with Islamic chants to drown out the Christmas music, the chants caused panic among some shoppers, police ordered the chanting to cease, the Muslims were from a mosque with known extremist ties)

Pakistan: Quetta, Balochistan

Four suicide bombers attacked a church during a children's Christmas Nativity pageant, police and parishioners shot two before they could gain entry to the church but one was able to detonate his vest, the other two fled, at least 14 were killed and 57 wounded, 9 critically

George Masih (aged 58, father of five, church groundskeeper and security guard, locked the church gate to deny entry to the killers, killed)

Sultan Masih (aged 40, husband, father of five, son of Siraj Masih, railroad ticket collector, had helped George Masih close the gate to the church courtyard, killed)

Mrs Masih (widow of Sultan Masih, said "I lost my champion, Sultan was my protector and now I feel so vulnerable. I have five children all in education and now we cannot even afford to pay our daily living expenses")

Gulzar Masih (aged 49, father of seven including Ramesh, laboratory technician, killed, had bolted the church door during the attack)

Ramish (aged 18, son of Gulzar Masih, injured in the head and right hand, said "I heard gunfire just as I and my younger brother Ishaq were bringing out the youngest children in the church for their nativity drama. My brother and I quickly pulled the children back into the room where they had been changing into costumes. Then a loud explosion occurred I later woke up in hospital...While there I discovered my brother, mother and father were also in hospital. My brother and mother survived but my father lost his life which is a brutal blow to our family. Our future is uncertain and we have lost a wonderful loving father who we all miss terribly...I will never be able to repay my father for everything he has done for me - it's heartbreaking")

Mehak (aged 13, daughter of Sohail Yousaf, sister of Wasiga, killed)

Wasiqa (aged 16, daughter of Sohail Yousaf, sister of Mehak, hospitalized in critical condition)

Sohail Yousaf (aged 44, father of four including Mehak and Wasiqa, insurance manager, said "It was a pleasant morning. We had sung songs and children had presented a Christmas program. Pastor Simon Bashir had finished his sermon and we were moving towards the altar when we started hearing gunfire outside the church...We bolted all the doors and were praying that God would protect each of us. Then a suicide bomber blew himself up at the main door. The explosion shattered the door and injured many inside. When some

rushed outside, they were injured by gunfire as the terrorists were on the church lawn. But soon the situation was brought under control by the volunteer church security guards and police present there...Losing my daughter at such a young age is morale-sapping I have not yet come to terms with her death. She was a beautiful, friendly and intelligent child that did nothing to hurt anyone. Every memory I have of her will be cherished she will never be forgotten")

Akash Masih (aged 19, college student, son of Naseem Masih and Parveen Bibi, killed)

Aster (aged 22, sister of Akash Masih, hospitalized due to shrapnel lodged in her intestines)

Naveed Masih (aged 15, brother of Akash Masih, shot in the elbow, hospitalized)

Parveen Bibi (wife of Naseem Masih, mother of six including Akash, Naveed, and Aster, hospitalized with head wounds, released)

Naseem Masih (husband of Parveen Bibi, father of six including Akash, Naveed, and Aster, said "My heart is broken, I have lost my handsome, intelligent wonderful son who was in command of his life and was heading towards a good future. His death has shattered our family, we all feel broken, we still cannot believe he is gone. It breaks my heart that I will never see him grow up...Our family is still going through great pain as we wait to see if Aster will survive, I pray on my knees night and day pleading with God to return her to me, it would be a cruel blow if we lose both children, we have done nothing to hurt these evil, twisted murderers, their attack makes no sense...God is our only hope in this country, I will never forsake Him, my family and I will all be back at church on Sunday. We are Christians it is what we do - despite the constant targeting")

Fazal Masih (aged 53, husband of Shenaz, father of five including Faraz, son of Malik Masih, welding shop owner, killed)

Shenaz (aged 42, widow of Fazal Masih)

Faraz (aged 22, son of Fazal Masih, said "It was the desire of my father that his all children obtain higher education but now we will all struggle without him. I was going to follow up my bachelors degree with a Master's Degree but now will have to find work to support my family...Our lives have been destroyed and filled with sorrow by some wicked men who are heartless. I hope the two men that are on the run are found and that their capture leads to the exposure of others who are planning similar attacks")

Sona Nazaf (daughter of Noaf Hameed, killed)

Madeeha Barkat (aged 29, daughter of Barkat Ali, sister of Danish Gill, partially disabled from polio, killed)

Danish Gill (aged 27, brother of Madeeha Barkat, said "Despite disabilities my sister was the most loving and caring sister I knew. She would make tea and would lay the table for me and my brothers when we came home from work and school. She was always the one who would open the door to me and I could talk to her about anything...She never complained about her disabilities and lived her life to the full. She survived such a debilitating illness and proved her worth ten times over, which is why her cruel death hurts so much. Our sister was a warrior - she conquered polio and life's difficulties but this heinous attack was too much for her. I will miss her every day of my life")

Salamti Bibi (aged 42, wife of Younas Masih, mother of three including Anum, killed)

Anun (aged 19, daughter of Salamti Bibi and Younas Masih, teacher, injured in the foot, said "We were in church, we were celebrating the birth of Jesus. We meant no harm to anyone, we were completely innocent. The two men involved in this attack killed my mother as they killed us all. All they had was hate, a deep rooted twisted hate, that meant they were devoid of compassion...Evil men like this have destroyed our country, they have shattered so many lives and now my family have experienced the same deep sorrow that others who have lost loved ones to a brutal unexpected death. It has shocked me to the core and I am finding it so hard to cope, my emotions are a mixture of anger, frustration and sorrow...I know I will see my mother in heaven one day, but the wait is so long and for now it is small solace. She has been the most beautiful thing in my life and now she is no longer there. I cry myself to sleep and I pray for her, I ask God to let her know that I love her so much")

Sunila Nidat (aged 35, wife of Nidat Masih, mother of Elijah and Zarek, daughter of Arif Bhatti, killed)

Nidat Masih (aged 44, agricultural engineer, widower of Sunila Nidat, father of Elijah and Zarek, injured, hospitalized, released, temporarily disabled, said "I lost the love of my life, my wife of 11 years. We had a very happy home and were enjoying bringing up our wonderful children. The blast took Sunila away from me and has left my children terrified, they think that church is a place to be feared, but it is not. It is these killers in our midst that should be feared as they are everywhere and they will no doubt attack us again and again because Christians are anathema...These people have no emotions they are brainwashed and taught that we are demons, but it is obvious who are innocent and evil in this attack...I have to care for my two boys without my wife and I know it will be hard but I will raise them into fine men whatever happens, I owe this to my wife's memory. She is a martyr who is with God now and though I want to pray that I am united with her soon I know I must first see my two boys to adulthood. I just hope she forgives me for failing to protect her from the Islamists that took her life")

Elijah (aged 9, son of Sunila Nidat and Nidat Masih, escaped uninjured due to his parents' actions, psychologically traumatized)

Zarek (aged 5, son of Sunila Nidat and Nidat Masih, escaped uninjured due to his parents' actions, psychologically traumatized)

Arif Bhatti (father of Sunila Nidat)

Ashraf (son of Manzoor, injured)

Sultan (son of Mizaj, injured)

Saiga (wife of Sohail, injured)

When I realized it was an attack, I immediately went to the school of catechism where the children were: I closed the door and pushed a wardrobe in front of the doors, to protect them")
- Aqil Anjum (shot in his right arm, said "The situation was so chaotic that my mind had numbed.

 My condition was such that I initially didn't even feel the bullet piercing my arm")
- Arooba Maryam (aged 15, shot in the abdomen, unable to attend school due to a stoma, said "I thank God that he allowed me to survive my injuries, I feel upset that I have survived when so many have lost their lives. I pray that God takes care of those who have fallen, they did not deserve to lose their lives")
- Aleeza (aged 18 months, daughter of Ashraf Masih, injured with shrapnel in her abdomen)
- Ashraf Masih (father of Aleeza, railroad station janitor, said "Aleeza survived very serious wounds at such a tender age and I can only believe that God has a great purpose for her life...My wife and I could not stop weeping when we thought she was dead, but God brought her back from the brink of death...We rejoice in our Lord who chose to preserve our child's life and we will dedicate her very existence to the furtherance of His Kingdom. Our God truly is great")
- Yousaf Khokhar (aged 58, widower, father of five, police constable, injured with glass shards, said "I have been praying for courage because the attack has left me feeling anxious and traumatized. I will never forget the loud sound of the explosion it still fills me with dread")

Nadia Younas (aged 19, sister of Saima and Aqsa, injured, Nativity pageant performer, said "I was in a queue for Holy Communion nearly all the church was in a line as we prepared to receive the bread, whilst awaiting my turn I could hear gun shots, I was in a fit of panic and did not know what to do. Thankfully Pastor Simon quickly instructed the church to sit or lay down on the floor, he told us to get as low as we could in whatever place we could find...We could hear bullets being fired and I felt a pain sear through my abdominal region I just screamed and screamed, then a loud blast was heard and I fell unconscious, I woke up later in hospital")

Aqsa (aged 10, sister of Nadia Younas and Saima)

Saima (aged 18, sister of Nadia Younas and Aqsa)

- Maheen Shezad (aged 14, daughter of Shezad Masih, injured in the abdomen and ankle with shrapnel, hospitalized)
- Shezad Masih (father of Maheen Shezad, received a minor head injury, hospitalized, released, said "I was so frightened I thought I was going to die. I still can't believe it happened so many people have been killed every time I remember what happened I just feel like crying. I will never forget this day it is a painful reminder that Christians are always in danger here in Pakistan")
- Shamim Bibi (aged 39, wife, mother of two, injured with shrapnel in the knee, hospitalized)
- Tina Qasim (aged 29, wife, mother of five, injured in the right shoulder with shrapnel, hospitalized, released)
- Adil Daniel (aged 28, husband of Salva Adil, father of Nida and Mariam, unemployed, injured with shrapnel in the left foot)
- Salva Adil (aged 26, wife of Adil Daniel, mother of Nida and Mariam, injured with shrapnel in the abdomen, discharged without completion of treatment)
- Ashraf Masih (aged 35, husband of Shazia, driver, shot in the back, hospitalized, both arms paralyzed, said "I was happy and content with life, my wife and were praying for a child but other than that everything was perfect. The men who shot me have left me with two paralyzed arms and I am terrified that I will never have movement back in them...I want Christians everywhere to pray for me, this is so unfair I have done nothing wrong and now only God can help me. He has saved my life now with their help and prayers I want to be able to hold my wife in my arms again and to be able to drive again that I might be able to support the two of us. Please pray for me")
- Rev Saimon Bashir Masih (said "Suddenly I heard the firing in church compound...Our church gatekeeper, George Masih, was the first person who fell to the terrorists' bullets...The worshippers panicked and cried loud for God's mercy. Seconds later, the windows shattered with explosion at the door. Some people were injured with ball bearings from the bomb. Those who were hit in the head collapsed on church benches...Thanks to our young volunteers and police guards, the terrorists could not enter inside the church hall packed with more than 400 people, including 80 children from Sunday school...We are lucky to be alive, but my congregation is like my family. I was single when I arrived in the city a decade ago and now all of my relatives are here. We spent more than a million [rupees] in decorating the building and polishing the furniture. I saw them die and I could

- not do anything", has been ordered to temporarily vacate his home, added that the church may not be able to reopen until after New Year's)
- Kal Alaxander (aged 52, present with his wife and two children. said "We were in services when we heard a big bang. Then there was shooting. The prayer hall's wooden door broke and fell on us...We hid the women and children under desks [pews?]")
- Sunil Pervaiz (present in the church with his sister, said: "We hid the women and children under the benches, but just then a deafening explosion occurred, breaking the wooden door and the glass windows. I saw several people covered in blood ... some were lying on the floor, some limping away to safety. It was sheer chaos")
- Mehreen Joseph (aged 43, 17-year-old son suffered multiple wounds, said "I am thankful to God Almighty that my son is alive, but my heart grieves for the families of our congregation who have lost their loved ones today. The church was brimming with activity for the pre-Christmas service, and we all were very excited to be there, but our happiness has been turned into sadness")
- Jacob Masih (said "People started running to the corners of the church when the firing started.

 All of this happened very quickly, leaving most of us in a state of shock and disbelief.

 Many, including myself, thought that it was the last day of our lives")
- Sidra Shams (said many of the children participating in the Nativity pageant were unharmed)
- Alizah (younger sister of Maryam George, hospitalized with two broken legs and other injuries) Maryam George (aged 20, sister of Alizeh)
- Sheezan William (Caritas Executive Director, said "I came to know what was happening while the exchange of fire was taking place. I phoned two youths in the choir. I could hear gunfire on the phone and then rushed to the church...The injured were taken to the Civil Hospital, CMH, Akram Hospital and other private hospitals. Relatives picked up two bodies from the church and took them away, which is why they are not counted in official numbering...A team of about 70 youths is working day and night to provide blood supplies, food or any other assistance to the injured, and coffins for the burial")
- Bishop Sadiq Daniel (said at the funerals following the church attack: "We are all in the same boat, terrorists are targeting everyone, they are attacking mosques, schools, universities, hospitals, armed forces, they want to destabilize Pakistan, they have their own political agenda. We, as followers of Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace, are opting for peace and we will work to maintain serenity and coexistence...Once again we are being put to the test...Our God, Emmanuel, the God-with-us who we celebrate at Christmas, is beside us and will console us, he takes care of us, he is fair and will do justice for his people")
- Archbishop Sebastian Francis Shah OFM (**UPDATE**: said "It was a day of sorrow for all Pakistanis and especially for Christians. It proves they don't believe in any religion, they neither respect worshippers or God...Military and religious leaders assured us that we are united as a nation. We are receiving messages of condolence from all religious communities...The enemy is not at the borders, but in our streets and surroundings")

However, this Christmas will be celebrated with simplicity", a police officer added that police have trained more than 100 church volunteers in armed self defense skills)

Rev Saimon Bashir Masih (**UPDATE**: said "I used to travel around the province with visitors without fear. Christians, living in scattered communities across the province, lived silently in peaceful co-existence. But Daesh [ISIL - Islamic State] terrorists are now targeting us one by one")

Pakistan: Sambrial. Sialkot district, Punjab province

Fr Victor Sawera (church attacked and vandalized by 50 armed men from a 'moderate' political party in retaliation for his refusal to allow a Protestant group to use the premises, said "This is our internal matter and Muslims should not get involved")

Fr Andraos Azmi (said the gunmen killed the 2 Muslim police officer outside the church "but we quickly shut the doors. However, they were able to kill some worshippers at the entrance")

Magdy Adel (aged 65, hid five worshippers in his store during the attack, said "The terrorist was very agitated when they closed the church's iron gate and he could not go inside. He had a lot of ammunition and kept shooting at the gate, killing some people inside")

Fr Antonio Daniel (said that the imam at the mosque across the street announced on the mosque loudspeakers that the church was under attack and called upon Muslims to rescue their 'Coptic brothers')

Ihab (Sunday school teacher, said "Following the end of the [Liturgy], as the congregation of the church began to leave and I began to collect the children to start Sunday School, we heard shooting outside the church. There was a situation of terror among all the people inside the yard: they all were screaming and running. The situation was terrible, the sound of the shooting was very dense and lasted more than 20 minutes. Many of the congregation who were in the church yard preparing to leave hurried inside when they heard the shooting. They hid inside the church and closed its inside door...The situation was very terrible, it was like war against the church, the sound of the shooting was very terrifying. Those terrorists used automatic weapons")

Abanoub (said "These terrorists arranged the attack of the church with precision. They knew everything about the church and the time of the ending the mass...One of them was

wearing suicide vest under his clothes and tried to enter the church while the worshippers were leaving the church to explode himself and kill many of them...First, the terrorists attacked the security men who were assigned to guard the church and they exchanged fire with them. The terrorist wearing the suicide vest tried to storm the church during the exchange of fire to explode himself inside, but the police managed to shoot him and prevent him from storming the church")

John Abdel-Messih (said "Muslims are not all terrorists. Security agents lost their lives defending the church. The sheikh of the mosque called on the residents of the neighborhood to rescue their Coptic brothers. Muslims actually detained one of the perpetrators, and many of them donated blood to hospitals that treated the wounded. There is still hope in this country")

It is harder for them to defend their basic rights...The resulting insecurity is evident today among the people, and some people are leaving the country for this reason. They are concerned for the future of their children. The situation has been exacerbated by various negative reports in the media, which have been exploited in order to poison the atmosphere...There are no equal rights for them in those areas where the Catholic minority finds itself in the midst of a majority of the other ethnic groups. This discrimination is expressed in political and administrative terms and above all where employment is concerned...")
