Chinar (wife of Pastor Zani, fled after the occupation of her city by the Turkish military and their allies, said "They were a group of people with weapons that entered our neighborhood and they were stealing. So, my cousin went out and asked them, 'what are you doing?' So, the men with weapons attacked my cousin's house and shot and killed his son")
