gatherings for prayers, physical attacks against innocent worshippers, use of laws to intimidate and harass institutions and persons")



Pakistan: Chak Jhumra district, Faisalabad

Saima (aged 24, daughter of Niaz and Rehana, cousin of Sinaha, domestic worker, arrested on false theft allegations on December 29, 2018 after she informed her employer of her impending marriage, repeatedly detained and beaten, threatened with sexual assault by police who undressed in her presence; **UPDATE**: hung by her arms and beaten, forced to drink boiling water, later briefly hospitalized but then returned to custody)

Sinaha (aged 11, cousin of Saima, neice of Rehana, repeatedly detained and beaten beginning on December 29, 2018, threatened with sexual assault by police who undressed in her presence; **UPDATE**: still in custody)

Rehana (wife of Niaz, mother of Saima, aunt of Sinaha, beaten by police during the December 29, 2018 search of her home for the alleged stolen gold, repeatedly detained and beaten; **UPDATE**: released)

Vietnam: Loc Hung

Authorities demolished church owned properties including a disabled veterans' home and homes of over 200 Christians families, all were offered inadequate compensation

- Ms Teresa H (said "They [The authorities] destroyed all our houses on the eve of Tet. Now we have to stay on the street. Where is the law in Vietnam?...After emigrating to southern Vietnam, my parents moved here in 1954, where we lived for four generations. Now, we are renting land in a cemetery")
- Mr Joseph Binh (said "There is no happiness in this Tet. As a father of three children, I feel sad and left out in this modern city, which lacks compassion and love. We rely on priests, who care about us and comfort us in such a difficult circumstance")
- Fr Anton Le Ngoc Thanh CSSR (**UPDATE**: complained after a home owned by his order was demolished and 18 disabled war veterans were thrown out on the street some without crutches and prosthetic limbs, religious statues were also seized, the veterans relocated to his monastery)
- Bishop Emeritus Michael Hoang Duc Oanh (**UPDATE**: later visited the homeless families, said "We must keep our faith in God, and listen to the Lord's words every day. We face many difficulties, but at the same time we are called to love and have compassion for others. Although Party cadres and local authorities have treated us with cruelty, we continue to love them as our brothers and sisters")

India: Delhi

- Dr Christo Thomas Philip (aged 36, U.S. citizen of Indian birth, deported on April 26, 2016 for 'evangelical and subversive activities', had been forcibly separated from his wife and three children, spent 24 hours in detention in Turkey after deportation; **UPDATE**: High Court ruled he has a right to practice his faith by providing pro bono medical services)
- Mrs Tehmina Arora (attorney; **UPDATE** said "This is a landmark judgment [that] protects the rights of foreign nationals working in Christian organizations to freely live out their faith in India")
- A. C. Michael (**UPDATE**: said the Court held the government "had acted without any complaints of law and order problems")

Auxiliary Bishop Theodore Mascarenhas SFX (**UPDATE**: said the ruling was an important precedent "If one's faith motivates one to volunteer for social service, one is free to do so. There is no law in India that stops people from doing so")

Netherlands: Free University, Amsterdam

Piet De Vries (theologian, signer of the Nashville Statement in favor of traditional Christian marriage, reported to have said "When the Nazi ideology was forced on, the churches were silent, now that gender ideology has begun, churches are silent too often, and we have to make ourselves heard", following that statement was told by his university that 'a line had been crossed' and that he would be brought up on disciplinary charges, prosecutors have been considering criminally charging him and the other 250 Dutch signers)

Pastor Koteswara Rao (new church demolished because it did not conform to Hindu building principles)

Pastor Konda Lazarus (said "That morning the village president's husband, also a local political leader, telephoned church pastor Koteswara Rao and asked him to be present at the meeting to discuss the matter, but Rao declined the invite as he was pre-occupied with his tasks for the day and said that he can be available the following day. This annoyed the leader, and he ordered the tribal men to demolish the church")

Algeria: Ain-Soltane village, Ain-Defla province

Ahmed Beghal (aged 32, alias, convert, father of two girls, reported to have said that after his divorce "They took my two daughters to prevent me from seeing them – whenever I asked to see my daughters in accordance with the rights granted by the judge, my wife's brothers created impediments and threatened me. This happened to me several times...Today I am far from my family, my wife, and my two daughters, without work or home. Such is the lot of a Muslim who converts to Christianity in Algeria today")

Bishop William H Love (aged 61, has been placed under a partial restriction by his presiding bishop after refusing to allow same sex marriages in his diocese, the refusal was sent in a letter to his diocese in November 2018 and stated that his church's 2018 General Convention requiring that all bishops approve same sex weddings was "in direct conflict and contradiction to God's intent for the sacrament of marriage as revealed through Holy Scripture")

Hu Shigen (church elder, disappeared on July 10, 2015; formally arrested in Tianjin on January 8, 2016 on a charge of 'subversion of state power'; sentenced in Beijing to 7 years' imprisonment on August 3, 2016; **UPDATE**: reported to be currently held in a prison hospital, forced to take unknown medications, health apparently not in decline but release on medical parole delayed until another prisoner has been prosecuted)

Egypt: Manshyet Zaafarana, Minya province

Bishop Makarios (**UPDATE**: issued a statement after police allowed Muslim protestors to close a house church and arrested two priests, later taking them to the police station in an animal control vehicle "This is not the first time a place used for worship by Copts in Minya is closed. The common factor among all closures, however, is that they were done to appease fundamentalists and extremists to the detriment of the Copts. It appears to indicate that extremists now hold the upper hand, and appeasing them is the easy way out of problems...This comes in the wake of declarations by the Grand Imam of al-Azhar, Sheikh Ahmad al-Tayyeb in favor of churches, also positive talk and actions by President Abdel-Fattah a-Sisi that every Egyptian has the right to practice his or her religion of choice, and to Pope Tawadros's efforts on that front")

Andro (attorney, said "The police behaved by an offensive way. They behaved with the priests as [they would with] killers. How dare the police cuff the priests!")

- Fr Sami (said "What happened frightened us. I am a priest and it is possible for the police to cuff me if the extremist neighboring Muslims protest or gathered in front of my church.

 Things are getting worse, but let us pray to make God keep us in peace")
- Mina (photographer, said "We could build the biggest cathedral in the desert! Now let us close the churches which are in poor places, where the poor and weak people can pray. The hate has become more direct and clear towards Christians")

- Fr Prakash Damor (arrested on charges of abetting a suicide, the teen girl reportedly left a note accusing him of pressuring her into conversion and marriage)
- Fr Rocky Shah (diocesan spokesman, **UPDATE**: said the diocese believes Fr Prakash Damor was framed and that "He will be exonerated in a court of law")
- Fr Julian Toppo (attorney, said police had not produced the alleged suicide note and that "As per the tribal culture, a boy and girl from the Damor community never marry as they are considered brother and sister. It can never happen")

Pakistan: Kasur district

Pervaiz Masih (husband of Zarina Bibi, father of Amir, Prem, Anmol, and Sanam, construction material supplier, accused of blasphemy by a business rival in Kasur district, arrested on September 1, 2015; released on bail on October 10, 2015; **UPDATE**: acquitted)

Sanam (aged 3, child of Pervaiz Masih and Zarina Bibi; **UPDATE**: reported to have drowned in a well while her parents were in police custody, anonymous callers said she had been killed in retribution)

Zarina Bibi (wife of Pervaiz Masih, mother of Amir, Prem, Anmol, and Sanam, family has received threats after her husband's September 1, 2015 arrest; **UPDATE**: reported to have been beaten by enemies of her husband, has since been unable to walk upright)

Iran: Tehran

Two Christians were ordered by a court to renounce their faith to avoid prison, both refused

Fatimeh Bakherti (aged 37, convert, home raided by police during a May 25, 2017 worship service, several Christians arrested; sentenced in Tehran on September 22, 2018 to 12 months' imprisonment for 'spreading propaganda against the regime'; **UPDATE**: refused to renounce her faith)

Saheb Fadaie (convert, home raided by VEVAK agents on February 16, 2015, religious items seized, warned on February 17, 2015 to leave the country; arrested on May 13, 2016; charged on September 10, 2016 with acting against national security and consumption of communion wine; called into court in Rasht on June 14, 2017 on charges of 'actions against national security, were accused of accepting a half million pounds from the British government, told they would receive a verdict in 20 days, a hardline judge then joined the hearings and said 'Christians make foolish claims'; sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment on June 24, 2017; arrested in Rasht on July 24, 2018, transferred to Evin Prison in Teheran; sentenced in Tehran on September 22, 2018 to 18 months' imprisonment for 'spreading propaganda against the regime', sentence to run concurrently with his current imprisonment; UPDATE: refused to renounce his faith)

United States – Kentucky: Covington

Nick Sandmann (parochial high school student, received death threats along with his family after returning home two days earlier from the March for Life in Washington DC, the threats originated from a video in which he was confronted by a Native American protestor at the Lincoln Memorial and from which several media outlets characterized his actions as racist, wrote in a statement "I was not intentionally making faces at the protestor. I did smile at one point because I wanted him to know that I was not going to become angry, intimidated or be provoked into a larger confrontation. I am a faithful Christian and practicing Catholic, and I always try to live up to the ideals my faith teaches me - to remain respectful of others, and to take no action that would lead to conflict or violence")

Fr Su Guipeng (disappeared into police custody in October 2018; **UPDATE**: released, banned from religious activities)



Turkey

Garo Paylan (aged 47, Member of Parliament, beaten in Parliament in Ankara on May 2, 2016 for refusing to vote to remove parliamentary immunity from some fellow members, called an 'Armenian bastard'; temporarily banned from Parliament after saying on January 13, 2017 "Between 1913 and 1923, we lost four peoples: Armenians, Greeks, Assyrians, and Jews were lost. They were either exposed to major massacres and genocides or subjected to population exchanges and exiles...We [Christians] used to account for 40 percent [of the country's population]. Now we are barely one out of a 1,000. It seems likely that something happened to us. I call it genocide. You can call it whatever you want. The Armenian people know very well what was done to them...I know very well what was done to my ancestors, my grandfather. To you, I am one of the 'leftovers of the sword'", the speech was deleted from the official record; beaten in Parliament on March 6, 2018 for stating that Turkey was perpetrating "ethnic cleansing" of Kurds in Syria; UPDATE: prosecutors have been reported to have filed a motion to strip him of his parliamentary immunity so that he can be prosecuted for his January 2017 speech)

Egypt: Cairo

Al Hadi Izzalden Shareef Osman (aged 40, convert, Sudanese citizen, fled Sudan in April 2014 after police accused him of apostasy and repeatedly arrested and tortured him, later said "One time they told me they were going to kill me if I do not return back to Islam. I fled Sudan for my life after I learned that my life was in danger"; apartment burglarized on August 15, 2018, passport stolen; **UPDATE**: reported to have received death threats, in hiding, said "My life is in great danger as Egypt is becoming an insecure place for me")

India: Kolhapur, Maharashtra state

Sr Bharati (secondary school principal, school attacked by about 20 youths from the Yuva Sena Hindu youth organization, said "They entered the campus with force, shouting slogans against the direction of the school and looted the office, while the nuns, frightened and disoriented, the students and the teachers were astonished and helpless. They started mistreating staff members, and when I asked them to stay calm and discuss the matter peacefully, they started to wreak havoc in the office, damaging even the religious items like the statues and the cross that were in the office. The attack was so sudden and atrocious, that the students were trembling with fear and are still in shock, we could not do anything except to observe")

Archbishop Thomas Dabre (**UPDATE**: condemned the Hindu attack on a girl's secondary school in which the windows were broken, the office ransacked, and crosses and religious statues damaged)

Basuki Tjahaja Purnama aka Ahok (former governor, sentenced in Jakarta on May 9, 2017 to 2 years' imprisonment on blasphemy charges despite the court ruling there was no evidence

of guilt and the prosecutorial recommendation of a suspended sentence; **UPDATE**: released)

Nicholas (son of Basuki Tjahaja Purnama aka Ahok, brought his father home from prison, wrote on Instagram "He's back. My dad's a free man! Thank you everyone for the support")

China

Huang Yan (aged 49, beaten by security officials in 2010, miscarried; beaten by security officials in 2012, miscarried, the beating continued while she was in the bathroom attending to the miscarriage; arrested on November 26, 2015, held in shackles until her ankles bled; reported on January 3, 2017 that government officials forced her doctors to cancel a procedure for ovarian cancer, is now in a 'safe location' but may not be able to afford the procedure; entered Taiwan on May 29, 2018, subjected to deportation back to China, deportation stopped after intervention from the UN High Commissioner for Refugees; **UPDATE**: granted asylum in the United States)

China: Hebei province

Bishop Cui Tai (aged 68, disappeared in mid-April 2018; **UPDATE**: allowed to return home, banned from religious activities, weighted only 115 pounds due to ill health)

Fr Zhao He (disappeared into police custody in October 2018; **UPDATE**: released, banned from religious activities)

Pakistan

The government refused to allow 14 young Christians to leave the country to attend World Youth Day

Paul Mohan (Diocese of Hyderabad Youth Commission coordinator, said "On the morning of January 23, we passed the security checks at the airport and collected the boarding passes to reach the Immigration Office. They kept us waiting for more than an hour and then they refused us permission. It was a very sad fact for the whole group, we tried a way out, talking with the members of the Office and with the officials of the airlines, we changed the ticket for the following day, paying a penalty and hoping that everything will be clarified. But the next day, the Office stopped us again, even though we all had a regular visa and the letters of accompaniment of the Bishops")

Atif Sharif ("Jesus Youth" movement coordinator, said "if you meet the criteria, if you have the regular documentation requested by the Consulates of foreign countries and you get a visa, a citizen must be free to leave, among other things, there was a huge investment for a trip abroad, and today our government discriminates against us")

Fr. Bonnie Mendez (**UPDATE**: said "The right to movement, including the right to travel, is a fundamental right of every citizen...government departments can not prevent people from traveling, if they have all the documents in place. At this point a political and legal battle is needed to protect this right. It is a matter that the Justice and Peace Commission or the Human Rights Commission will have to face")

He's in hiding in Pakistan and his family are terribly worried for him...Just pray for Asher's safety - that is paramount. At the moment he has no funds to live on - he can't work. Pray for Asher's family that they can get the support and the legal help needed and just pray for the whole community because the whole community has been rocked by this latest event. Pray that the [UK] government will see sense. I would ask them to look again and bring Asher home to where he is safe...[Foreign Secretary] Jeremy Hunt on the 18th January - just this week - was talking with the Open Doors UK

charity and said, 'no one should face persecution for their faith where ever they are' and that includes Christians. But the UK is sending people back to these countries where their lives are in danger.
