Syria: Aleppo

Fr Ibrahim Alsabagh OFM (aged 47; **UPDATE**: said of his home "It is a wounded city, with broken wings. Its economy is destroyed and must be rebuilt almost from scratch. There is a widespread feeling of sadness and bitterness. When we are asked how things are, we usually reply that the war has just begun, because now the wounds are beginning to emerge in all their depth...The deepest wounds concern the human being, the heart and

the soul of many children raised during the war which show evident psychological fragility...As Christians we are always threatened with disappearing, in Syria as in the whole Middle East. The community lives suspended between heaven and earth, we are hung on the Cross, in suffering, in bitterness. Eight years ago we entered a tunnel that, even today, it does not seem to have an end...")

Dennis Christensen (aged 46, Danish citizen, husband of Irina, arrested on May 25, 2017 for 'continuing the activities of a banned extremist organization', ordered held for 2 months pending trial; detention extended on July 20, 2017 to November 23, 2017; denied bail on November 20, 2017, detention extended to February 23, 2018; **UPDATE**: convicted, sentenced to 6 years' imprisonment)

Irina Christensen (wife of Dennis Christensen, said "It is terrible, a 6-year jail sentence for believing in God. I couldn't believe that such a thing could happen in Russia")

Yaroslav Sivulsky (said "The sentence causes only great regret. They have convicted a man who has committed no crime. It is sad that in Russia it has again become a crime to read the Bible, to keep its commandments, and to talk about your faith with other people")

At least 10 churches were desecrated within 2 weeks

This act of profanation hurts us all in our deepest convictions")

Kristina Schrock (InterVarsity Graduate Christian Fellowship president, brought suit in Federal Court on August 6, 2018 against the University of Iowa in Iowa City after it decertified all student groups that had restrictions on officers including adherence to an article of faith; UPDATE: thanked the court when it ruled in favor of Business Leaders in Christ, her Fellowship's suit is still pending)

Thursday February 7, 2019



India: Chapar village, Sultanpur district, Uttar Pradesh state

Prayer service in a home attacked by 25 Hindu radicals, Bibles burned

Ranjeet Kumar Gautam (husband of Bindu, father of Swasti and five others, home attacked, said "Before the Thakurs [high caste members] attacked the worship service, they took two photos of Hindu idols from my neighbor's house and tore it and threw it in my backyard. They tried to create havoc alleging that we are insulting their gods, but we defended ourselves saying that they must enquire from the villagers about our conduct...They seized each worshipper – men and women – and beat us with wooden sticks, with their legs and fists. They spared nobody except children. Every single Christian was surrounded by five or six men and, taking turns, they ruthlessly beat us. It seemed that the ordeal will never come to an end, and that we will all get killed. The Thakurs forced us to lick their feet with our tongues, threatening to assault us further if we did not comply. Eight of us did what they said, to save ourselves from their brutality. They forced us to say, 'Jai Shri Ram [Hail, lord Ram],' to which three Christians complied, but the rest of us refused and said that we would rather die...In their barbarousness, they threw Mukesh [Kumar] into the manhole that was filled with human excrement, and when he struggled to escape, they pulled him back and threw him in again. Then they pulled him up and started to kick him. They tossed him among each, using him like a football with their feet. As a result of the brutal assault, blood began to ooze out of Mukesh's ears and eyes", went into hiding, later said "Nearly every day the attackers come and threaten my family, saying that if I register a complaint with police, they will kill me. My family is very scared")

Bindu (wife of Ranjeet Kumar Gautam, mother of Swasti and five others, home attacked, later unable to find work while her husband was in hiding)

Swasti (aged 19, daughter of Bindu and Ranjeet Kumar Gautam, recently engaged, home attacked, beaten with sticks, slapped, kicked in the abdomen)

Pastor Om Prakash (said "They were not expecting so many of us there and so got busy beating all of us and could not focus on Gautam alone...They snatched our bags, cell phones and collected all the Bibles — about 45 in number, and tore them apart...The assailants chased us away from the hospital. We somehow reached the local police station to report the matter to the police at 10 in the night, and a group of Bajrang Dal [the RSS paramilitary youth wing] people were standing outside the police station. They threatened to kill us if we filed a complaint against them, and we had to flee for our lives", suffered injuries to his head, shoulder, ribs, and hip, later said "I start to feel dizzy, and my head spins even after a little amount of work. I have developed breathing difficulty and cannot tolerate loud sounds. I am also unable to walk without a back-support belt")

Gyanmati Nishad (aged 35, blind, slapped and punched, later hospitalized)

Mukesh Kumar (aged 26, beaten, pushed into a cesspool, kicked until he bled from eyes and ears, later hospitalized)

Rakesh (seriously injured)

Bhanu Pratap (seriously injured)

Pastor P David (**UPDATE**: later said "It is a matter of shame that peaceful people, meeting and fellowshipping inside their own homes, are attacked by religious extremists. Not only their fellowship is disrupted, but they are beaten mercilessly and are not allowed to get their medical examination nor even allowed to register a police complaint. It is a mockery of law and order, there is chaos in the country")

Cardinal Timothy Dolan (**UPDATE**: responded to an attack on him by Governor Andrew Cuomo over his criticism of the governor for passage of a new abortion bill

"Today...Governor Cuomo linked me with the 'religious right'...This is something new from the governor. He did not consider me part of the 'religious right' when seeking my help with the minimum wage increase, prison reform, protection of migrant workers, a welcome of immigrants and refugees, and advocacy for college programs for the state's inmate population, which we were happy to partner with him on, because they were our causes too. I guess I was part of the 'religious left' in those cases...The governor also continues his attempt to reduce the advocacy for the human rights of the pre-born infant to a 'Catholic issue', an insult to our allies of so many religions, or none at all...")

Pakistan: Lahore Shafaqat Emmanuel (aged 40, husband of Shagufta Bibi, father of two, handicapped, arrested on July 27, 2013 for allegedly sending a blasphemous text message; confessed sending the blasphemous text message after being tortured and told by the police that his wife would be tortured; moved to the jail hospital with multiple bed sores which are reportedly more than 3 inches deep, will require surgery if he survives; found guilty at trial on April 4, 2014, sentenced to death; **UPDATE**: still imprisoned on death row)

Shagufta Kauser (aged 40, wife of Shafaqat Emmanuel, mother of two, school worker, arrested on July 27, 2013 for allegedly sending a blasphemous text message; forced along with her children to watch the torture of her husband by the police; found guilty at trial on April 4, 2014, sentenced to death; **UPDATE**: still imprisoned on death row)

Pakistan: Rawalpindi

Zafar Bhatti (aged 49, husband of Nawab Bibi, unemployed due to health reasons, illiterate, arrested on blasphemy charges on July 23, 2012 for allegedly sending 3 blasphemous text messages to extremist Islamic cleric Molvi Abrar Ahmed; convicted in Rawalpindi on

May 3, 2017, sentenced to life imprisonment; **UPDATE**: appeal underway, said "I've been suffering in jail for over 5 years for something I did not do. The isolation and hardship of jail has caused me to develop diabetes. I was arrested under questionable circumstances, and despite there being no evidence found against me I am still in the jail...There are many security concerns within jail but I still stand firm in the faith. I believe God will provide justice to me soon")

Nawab Bibi (aged 70, wife of Zafar Bhatti, housemaid, abused by her employer, hospitalized due to poor health, released)

Shibu Thomas (Persecution Relief; **UPDATE**: said of the murder of Anant Ram Gand "Being a Christian today in India means being harassed every day: if you pray in the family you are beaten, if you pray in a domestic church you are beaten, in the streets you are beaten...I ask the prime minister and the Chief minister of the State to please order a probe. The government should provide compensation to the family and five small children. They should speak clearly against persecution of Christians and to protect freedom of worship. Enough is enough!")

Dr. John Dayal (All India Christian Council; **UPDATE**: reported that the government has cancelled the licenses of 15,000 foreign charity NGOs since 2014, said "Every Indian government, but especially the current one led by the Hindu nationalist BJP [Bharatiya Janata Party], has been hostile to international organizations and media scrutiny...[because they investigate the] real situation, such as extreme poverty, suicides among farmers, rape, human rights violations and civil liberties, and above all religious freedom...India does not usually grant a visa to United Nations special envoys to investigate human rights. It is very hostile to them. This is especially true when Western governments raise questions about the treatment of Christians, Muslims and Dalits...[this] weakens the voice of India's own human rights community, which needs access to domestic and international media to amplify its voice, [but] the truth in the end will come to the fore and the human rights community will find alternative ways to speak out and put the spotlight on what is happening...the lives of millions of beneficiaries who receive aid from the West are at risk. What started as mere suspicion towards groups headquartered in New York or Europe has morphed into full blown paranoia")

Pastor Micael Grenholm (wrote against the government asylum test 'Am I a Christian" which only 60% of Swedish citizens could pass, one application was denied asylum because he could not explain Halloween, another was deported over a minor mistranslation of the Our Father, wrote in particular "Most people agree that the questions converts face are too hard and do not really say anything about whether someone's faith is genuine or not. Several questions display a secular bias and an ignorance of what true Christian faith is about...This is a full-blown catastrophe. Genuine Christians are being deported to countries where Christians are persecuted simply because Swedish government officials are incompetent and hostile towards Christianity")

Archimandrite Gideon Kharon (U.S. citizen, forgave the arsonists who attacked his monastery on January 25, 2018; issued a statement on February 3, 2018 regarding ultranationalist threats against the Tithes Monastery of the Mother of God, Kiev; UPDATE: detained upon re-entry to the country after returning from the United States where he had testified to Members of Congress on the situation in the country, passport seized and then declared lost, denied access to attorneys, Members of Parliament, and medication, stripped of his Ukrainian citizenship and deported under armed escort, said "They didn't let me into Ukraine, arguing that my citizenship has been canceled, that it's invalid, although just 15 days ago I flew out without any problems or any kind of court decision...It's just such religious and political pressure and lawlessness that's happening in Ukraine today")

Uprooted from her daily routine, left to suffer alone, all of us, her cosisters, Superiors, Bishops, priests and all who know her and are convinced of her innocence can only look up to heaven in helplessness and hope, as every attempt to even get bail for her has been brusquely rejected by our judiciary at various levels sometimes in a matter of minutes...Many like her are languishing in jail as under trials waiting for the slow churning of the wheels of justice which often appear to be spun by money power, political clout, massive media propaganda and even blatant manipulation of evidence")

Dr Nabil Antaki (testified "all the armed rebel groups are now amassed in the province of Idlib. Al-Nusra, the local emanation of al-Qaeda, recognized as a terrorist group by the UN and the international community, is in the process of eliminating or engulfing all other movements, of Islamic inspiration, with the force of weapons. For months, the Syrian army has wanted to launch an offensive to free the latter province from the hands of terrorists, 30 thousand of them foreigners, but the Western powers, through the intermediation of Russia and Turkey, are preventing it. The reason given: The risk of a serious humanitarian crisis. The real reason, as has emerged from some voices of Western leaders: what to do with all the foreign terrorists who would flee to Europe, in case the offensive was launched...On the other hand, a war is unfolding on our territory and it is the one that pits Turkey against the Kurdish militias. Finally, the Americans who illegally established two bases in a sovereign nation, today want to withdraw following the decision of President Donald Trump. But his administration, like Congress, are incapable of reaching agreement on this strategy and try to sabotage it by all means possible...We are angry at the sanctions imposed by the European Union and the United States against Syria, which only exacerbate the humanitarian situation without having any impact on the end of hostilities and the establishment of peace. The exodus of the Syrians, especially the Christians, continues. Moreover it seems to have increased beyond the levels of the dark hours of the war. The apostolic nuncio to Syria, Card. Mario Zenari, said during a congress in Hungary that Christians are now no more than 2% of the total population. That is half a million, out of a total of 23 million citizens. We knew this, but it is the first time that these figures have been revealed in public. My city, Aleppo, which had a population of about 150/200 thousand Christians in 2011, before the war, today does not count more than 25 thousand, at most 30 thousand. Syria, the cradle of Christianity, is emptying of its Christian population...")
