Jiang Tianyong (aged 47, husband of Jin Bianling, son of Jiang Lianghou, human rights attorney, abducted by police in Changsha, Hunan province on November 22, 2016; charged with 'subversion of state power' on May 31, 2017; sentenced to 2 years' imprisonment on November 20, 2017; as of June 27, 2018 had been forced to take an unidentified medication in prison and has shown a memory deficit as a possible result, legs appear to have been injured due to torture or shackles, has been denied access to clothing and money sent by his family; released from prison on February 28, 2019, disappeared, father and sister disappeared; UPDATE: allowed to returned home with his father and sister, wife has begun a petition for him to travel to the U.S. for medical treatment)

India: Ranchi, Jharkhand state

Church prayer service for a newlywed couple was attacked by the husband's parents and neighbors

Risha Toppo (convert, newlywed and secret husband of Roshani Kachhap, church attacked by his parents during a prayer service, dragged to the police station along with his wife and her parents, banished from the community, said "...my parents and a mob of extremists from our village came to the church and took my wife and me to the police station. My mother accused my wife and her family of forcefully converting me...I left everything behind and followed Christ. Today we are surviving with the help of a basic salary I receive from working in a private clinic and my wife's payments from tutoring some school students. We are working very hard but are happy that we are leading a Christian life")

Roshani Kachhap (newlywed and secret wife of Risha Toppo, church attacked by her husband's parents during a prayer service, dragged to the police station along with her husband and her parents, accused with her parents of forcibly converting her husband despite his conversion occurring 4 years earlier and his continued residence with his parents)

Pakistan: Iqbal town, Islamabad

Saima Iqbal (aged 35, wife of Naveed Iqbal, mother of Mikael, Danish, and Qamar, abducted at gunpoint on February 25, 2019 and forced into an Islamic marriage, police refused to file a report for over a week; **UPDATE**: recovered by police, placed into an Islamic women's shelter due to documents falsely claiming she converted to Islam)

Naveed Iqbal (aged 37, husband of Saima Iqbal, father of Mikael, Danish, and Qamar, said after his wife's February 25, 2019 abduction "I was living here very happily for the past 18 years until on the night of 25 February 2019 when the mother of my children was kidnapped at the gun point by Pathan Khalid Satti who is part of criminal gang...As soon I came to know what happened to my wife, on the 26th February I reported the incident but the police refused to file my complaint and delayed the registration"; **UPDATE**: said "When I met her [Saima his wife] in the Dar ul Iman [women's shelter] I saw visible marks of torture on her face and body...Nobody is listening to us and every time we are only hear these lines from the people in authority that she has accepted Islam and now is she is in Muslim Nikkah [marriage]. Is this the way the minorities suffer in Pakistan?...This is my request please help me. I am now in hiding along with our children

moving from place to place due to threats. They have forcibly taken falsified statements from Saima Iqbal, and she remains in great fear for us")

Shamil Rasulovich Khakimov (aged 68, widower, pensioner, harassed with repeated phone calls from police on January 28, 2019 after his number was found on the phone of a detained Christian; summoned for interrogation at the police station on February 1, 2019; arrested on February 16, 2019; placed in pre-trial detention for two months on February 18, 2019, health in jail good despite high blood pressure and a recent leg surgery, denied a Bible; **UPDATE**: charged with 'inciting religious hatred')

India: Pandawa Tanda, Jharkhand state

Belu Ganjo (wife beaten by fellow villagers and threatened with drowning, beaten when he attempted to rescue her, 4 year old daughter forcibly thrown to the floor from upstretched arms but suffered only minor injuries, fled the village, returned after police intervened)

Pastor Manoj Munda (described the attack on the family of Belu Ganjo "The entire village surrounded her [Belu Ganjo's wife] and had decided to tie her with a rope and drown her in the well...The mob lifted up their 4-year-old daughter and forcefully threw her to the floor. By God's grace, the child suffered only minor injuries. Ganjo ran for his life with his child and wife to another Christian's house, but the angry mob followed them, so they locked their houses, and in that night they fled away from the village...Even at the police station [the next day], they were shouting that Ganjo accepted a foreign faith and that they should not enter the village until they renounce Christianity. But police told them that the Christians can freely live out their faith, and nobody must stop them")

Pakistan: Imranpura, Wadiala, Sialkot district, Punjab province

Stephen Masih (aged 38 or 42, brother of Alia and Francis, mentally disabled, beaten by a mob after he was heard yelling at his family about Lent, arrested on blasphemy charges)

Francis Masih (brother of Stephen Masih, said that after Stephen began to yell about Lent: "This is when Mudassir barged into our house and started beating Stephen without any reason. We told Mudassir that it was not right for him to intervene in our family issue, but he took offense and raised hue and cry in the street, alleging that Stephen had committed blasphemy. Mudassir and Mohammad Rafiq, another neighbor, provoked them to attack Stephen. They not only beat him up mercilessly but also attacked other family members who tried to save him...The police took my brother away, and it was after some time that we learned that he had been charged with blasphemy. We have been running from pillar to post, as we are very worried about his condition, especially since he was ruthlessly beaten up by the mob, but the police are not arranging our meeting. They keep telling us that he is safe and being taken care of")

Cardinal George Pell (aged 77, charged with multiple child sex abuse crimes in June 2017, the police had opened a case against him a year before a complainant was found, most charges were then dismissed for "fundamental defects in evidence"; reported on December 11, 2018 to have been convicted on five counts despite the trial having been held in secret, a previously unreported trial had ended in mistrial after 10 jurors voted to acquit, trial witnesses anonymously reported extensive prosecutorial misconduct; verdict announced on February 27, 2019 after prosecutors decided to drop the remaining charges, taken into custody; **UPDATE**: sentenced to 6 years' imprisonment, appeal underway)

A C Michael (**UPDATE**: said "These moves are part of a pattern to oppress Christians. At least 12 states in India are set to have elections on April 18, this year's Maundy Thursday. That itself is a big setback")

Netherlands

Converts from Islam described continuing death threats

Faraidoun Fouad (convert, said "I converted in 1999. In 2002 God called me to reach out to my own people. Directly after my conversion to Christianity I received the first threats. People who I thought were my friends, became my enemies. Even Muslims who are not very conservative told my wife that they would kill me...I receive threats every day. When I post something on Facebook, I often receive hateful reactions")

Esther Mulder (convert, said "After my conversion, the threats started. Especially on Facebook. Most of the time they're coming from other Somalis. They write to me in Somali, so no one else is able to understand what they're saying. We once posted a picture of a Somali

conference where everyone was standing in front of a cross. People didn't like it and we received several threats")

Brother Jassim (convert, Facebook account blocked, said "In 2015 I became a Christian. I was baptized on April 24, 2016, on my birthday...My mother taught me to respect everyone and to be kind. That was in stark contrast to what Islam was teaching me. I had to hate and curse Jews and Christians. Muhammed was my big role model, but his life was bad. He killed Jews and married a girl of six. How could he be my role model?", printed 8 pages of threats for the police)

Friday March 15, 2019



New Zealand: Auckland

Fr Douglas al-Bazi (aged 47, abducted in Bagdad, Iraq, in November 2006, shot in the leg, teeth knocked out, released after 9 days; said in Ankawa, Kurdistan, Iraq on December 29, 2014 "I care about my people. I don't care about the 'Middle East.' The Middle East for almost 2,000 years has been the same. It's the same war, the same conflict. So, why do I have to put my people inside that war? Why?...I am angry because I know Islam very well. In Baghdad they blew up my church. I drove by three bombings, and twice my car was destroyed. I got shot in my leg by an AK-47 – by Islam, and they kidnapped me for nine days...You know who represents Islam very well? ISIL. They are the true Islam. So if someone says, 'No, they do not represent Islam, Hamas does not represent Islam, Hezbollah does not represent Islam.' Who's left then? Come on guys. Come on. Wake up. You know, stop saying those stupid things – it's just stupid. What for? If I lose the last drop of our blood [by encouraging Christians to stay], what is the point of that?"; **UPDATE**: counselled his parishioners who feared a retaliatory attack following the mass murder of Muslims at two mosques in Christchurch, said "I am still shocked, me and my people, how this could happen here in New Zealand...we fully understand as Iraqi people, especially Christian, we really understand, because we are survivors of genocide, systematic genocide...There is a lady in my community -- they beheaded her son in front of her. Another man, they killed his parents in front of him...I told them, no, this is not the time to be scared. It is the time to be united...I don't know what we can do for those survivors [of the mosque attacks], for those relatives, the only thing we can do is pray for them and say, 'This is not New Zealand'", sent a floral tribute with a message of support in Arabic to a nearby mosque)

It was difficult to escape. They began shouting, beating and insulting me as an 'infidel' and

enemy of the Islamic religion", fled and later found unconscious, hospitalized for two days, wife and children fled to a Christian neighbor)

Nigeria: Nandu Gbok village, Sanga county, Kaduna state

Amos Samuel (aged 40, said "We were all asleep in our various homes when at about 4 a.m., we heard gunshots everywhere in my village. Everyone ran out of their homes to escape from the Fulani herdsmen. Three hours after the herdsmen left, those of us who survived the attack returned to the village to find that our houses were destroyed and 10 of our villagers killed")

Charles Danladi (county chairman, said "The attack occurred while the villagers were still sleeping. Normalcy has now been restored in the village, and we are making efforts to assist victims")

Shehu Nicholas Garba (National Assembly member, local resident, stated in a press release "about 10 [people were killed and] about 30 [houses were burned]...Our communities are helpless and are pleading that all persons of conscience should speak out")

Nigeria: Kajuru county, Kaduna state

Luke Waziri (attorney, wrote that 130 Christians were killed in a series of attacks: "Kajuru land and by extension the Adara nation has been gripped by a fully funded and supported group of terrorists that have been wreaking havoc in our lands for long, while those saddled with the responsibility of securing us deliberately looked the other way. First, Ungwan Barde was attacked on February 10, 2019, and nobody said anything, even though those in government knew. Furthermore, the government pretended that the 11 people killed didn't matter...While the victims [of a February 26, 2019 attack in Karamai] were buried in a mass grave and the injured yet to recover, Ungwan Barde village was attacked again on Sunday, March 10. Seventeen people were killed and dozens of houses burned...The smoke had barely settled [from attacks in Inkirimi and Dogonnoma villages in Maro on March 11, 2019 which killed 52] when an attack was launched in the [same] evening at Ungwan Gora [Labi Village], with dozens injured and 43 houses burned

down...In all these, not a single person has been arrested, nor even questioned. This is despite the fact that all the attacks took place either in the morning or in the evening – in full glare of everyone. However, in a strange twist of the application of justice, nine Adara elders and village chiefs were indiscriminately arrested and thrown into the Kaduna prison on allegations of complicity. The victims that have been killed and brutalized are the same ones being arrested and thrown into prison, while the real killers are being pampered, supported and allowed to freely continue their onslaught on people and our land")

The Hindutva ideology of intolerance and impunity is spreading in this state, inciting people to harass and attack religious minorities...")

- Joy Danlami (aged 19, daughter of Danlami Mante, sister of Patience and Aboy Danlami, ambushed by Fulani Muslim herdsmen, beaten, raped, shot dead)
- Patience Danlami (aged 16, daughter of Danlami Mante, sister of Joy and Aboy Danlami, ambushed by Fulani Muslim herdsmen, escaped with machete and gunshot wounds)
- Aboy Danlam (aged 14, son of Danlami Mante, brother of Joy and Patience Danlami, ambushed by Fulani Muslim herdsmen, escaped with machete and gunshot wounds)
- Danlami Mante (father of Joy, Patience and Aboy Danlami, said "The armed herdsmen chased them with dangerous weapons. Joy's nose and face was battered, and then she was sexually assaulted by the herdsmen before being killed. She was shot", said the herdsmen proceeded to their village and burned 17 homes)
- Pastor Samson Gamu Yare (later said "We are faced with the burden of caring for those who fled the two villages in order to escape from the herdsmen carnage")

Nepal: Sarlahi district

Pastor Dhurba Kumar Pariyar (aged 40, beaten after delivering toys and stationery to Dalit [untouchable] children, said "One of them caught hold of me from my chest and pulled me down from my motorbike and dragged me towards the jungle. They said I am preaching foreign religion, converting people and 'feeding' on dollars in return. They asked me to hand over all the [supposed U.S.] dollars I am carrying to them, and they will spare my life. I asked them who were they to question my work and demand money from me, to which they said they were 'underground Maoists'...They fled while warning me, 'If you continue to preach the Jesus religion, we will not spare you — we will come and kill you, wherever you may go")

Seyi Omooba (daughter of Pastor Ade Omooba, actress, threatened with termination from a theater production on March 15, 2019 after the discovery of a four year old Facebook post that defended traditional Christian morality, ordered to make no public statements; UPDATE: fired from the theater production after a public statement falsely attributed to her was published on the internet, blacklisted, told she would be rehired when she '[came] to her senses on this matter' and 'got away from the ideologies of your entire upbringing', said "...the theatre and the agency gave me the choice of either losing my career or renouncing my faith. I could not do this, not even to save the career that I love", later filed suit to recover her positions)

Andrea Minichiello Williams (Chief Executive of Christian Concerns; UPDATE: later said "What happened to Seyi Omooba was cruel and has damaged the career of a highly talented young artist for a Facebook post she had made four years earlier. This is another in a string of cases involving Christians being hounded out of their careers because they love Jesus...This story sends a chilling message to Christians, not only in the theatre industry but across our society, that if you express and hold mainstream Biblical views, you will be punished and will lose your career if you do not immediately renounce your

beliefs. This cannot go unchallenged and we are determined to fight for justice in this case")

services "This will compress the survival space of house churches. Not only will they have to deal with the official crackdown but now also the threat from their neighbors")

Li (reported "[The government's] suppression of churches is getting stronger and stronger. Now, we do not dare to hold public activities. Some people were taken to the police station for questioning simply because they were distributing Gospel leaflets in public, so we have stopped distributing the Gospel leaflets. The community officials are also very alert about gatherings. They ask the residents to keep their eyes on Christians and to report any Christian gathering as soon as possible, and they will be rewarded")

China: Hebei province

Bishop Augustine Cui Tai (aged 68, disappeared in mid-April 2018; allowed to return home on January 24, 2019, banned from religious activities, weighted only 115 pounds due to ill health; **UPDATE**: arrested)

But the shopkeepers have been warned from selling goods to us. They will not grind our wheat and will not sell some rice or oil also. We are treated as untouchables, but we have not stopped gathering for worship on Sundays")

Two Christians were arrested on illegal conversion allegations, they had asked a Hindu niece who was literate to read the Bible to them since they could not read it, the two were released without charge at midnight
