While I shared the Gospel I faced lots of problems because six families accepted Jesus from majority [i.e. Muslim] background. I was in prison but my faith was strong and therefore God rescued me from danger. Now we have 153 baptized members and God is increasing my ministry")

India: Gadiras village, Chhattisgarh state

Sodi Joga (convert, husband, father of a 5 year old daughter, expelled from his village along with his family, wrote in his police complaint that they had been harassed for three months "They would quarrel with us over trivial issues and link it with our Christian faith. We had been quiet and never said a word")

Dudhi Bandi (church elder, described the persecution of Sodi Joga and his family "The villagers demanded that Joga and his family must partake in the cleansing ritual, a puja, which would cleanse them of Christianity and restore them to their previous faith. But they refused to bow to the tribal deities. The villagers threw out the belongings, animals and chickens owned by Sodi Joga. Joga did not know where to go. It was his relatives and kinsmen who were threatening that they would kill him, his wife and 5-year-old daughter...I pray for the Lord's protection over them. Usually in such cases, the village council would let Naxals [Maoist militants] take over, and they won't hesitate to take lives. We had already counselled them and made them aware about these dangers")

India: Ranbir Singh Pora area, Jammu district

The August 2019 abrogation of the Indian Constitution provisions regarding Jammu and Kashmir and the imposition of direct rule from New Delhi resulted in a curtailment of organized Christian worship

Pastor Mohan Lal Kaith (detained by police while leading worship in a parishioner's home on November 10, 2019, threatened, released in the evening; **UPDATE**: detained by police, threatened, released in the evening, later said "Then I told him [the police station officer] that, 'I have not violated the Indian Constitution, and I abide by every word written in it as framed by its makers. If still you see fault in me, it is fine – you can forcefully frame me in any case that would incriminate me for sharing about Christ, but I will not stop", added that he had been threatened for months: "Every few minutes I received a message that the Bajrang Dal [the RSS paramilitary youth wing] and Ram Sevaks are aware of where I am, and that they are observing me closely, and that I should preach about Hindu gods while sharing about Christ, and that if I failed to do so they would punish me with death. The neighbors in the village keep watch on me, and if they see me going out for prayer, immediately the message passes on, and a mob of Ram Sevaks and Bajrang Dal reach there to disrupt the prayer service. They use filthy language, so that we can never have a proper dialogue with them")

He [Fr Hovsep Hanna Petoyan] also carried out his pastoral work among them, and for a long time he also followed the projects implemented with the help of international groups to rebuild the church and the houses of the Christians in Deir ez Zor, destroyed by the war. For this reason he went to Deir ez Zor every two weeks to check the progress of the work. He had already carried out six trips to that city so dear to the memory of the Armenians, where there is the shrine of the martyrs of the genocide, also devastated during the conflict...For us they are martyrs. And what happened to them is a confirmation that the war is not over here, as we had hoped")

Minakshi Singh (reported: "Atrocities against Christians are on the rise. In 2014, about 150 episodes of violence against the community were reported. In 2016, the count rose to 200 and in 2017 it went up to 270 accidents. In 2018, there were 292 episodes of violence against Christians. In 2019 [until September] 247 cases were reported, 60 of which in the

state of Uttar Pradesh. In the past year, 40 churches have been closed due to violence. In Chhattisgarh, communities and other Christian groups even face a social boycott. We ask the government to end the harassment towards pastors, priests and violence against the Christian community")

- A C Michael (United Christian Forum; **UPDATE**: said "Religious minorities, like Christians and Muslims, are targeted by nationalist Hindu groups. For this reason urgent measures are needed against the groups responsible for this violence", also spoke against so-called 'Freedom of Religion Acts' in seven Indian states: "These laws should be immediately withdrawn to ensure total religious freedom")
- Bishop Emeritus Karam Masih (said: "Our rights should be protected. We are peace loving people. The government should do everything to keep peace. The government should support constitutional values")

India: Parihara village, Garhwa district, Jharkhand state

- Rev Basant Kumar Paul (husband and father, attacked by 8 or 9 RSS paramilitary members in his home during a prayer meeting, hospitalized, elderly mother beaten, son hospitalized with a broken leg, wife hospitalized in critical condition with a coma, personal property stolen)
- Rev Patsy David (reported on the attack on Rev Basant Kumar Paul: "fanatics came to the house church, and started abusing and beating everyone...[he was able to reach] the police station and file a complaint, and then fainted. After that the police took him to hospital, where he was admitted")
- Shibu Thomas (Persecution Relief; **UPDATE**: reported on the attack on Rev Basant Kumar Paul: "Fanatics are taking full advantage of it [the 2017 anti-conversion law] and are beating and assaulting innocent people. False complaints [about forced conversions] are being filed against Catholic nuns, priests, pastors and [Protestant] believers. They strike and lynch Muslims at will. Ghar Wapsi ['homecomings' forced conversion to Hinduism] have become regular features. The Chief Minister [state governor] and others are mum about it. They should speak, loud and clear. Tribals are being harassed and forced into reconversion [editor: this is a slight misstatement, since tribals generally were never Hindus]")

They are fine, but they are experiencing a natural state of helplessness and pain. It pains us that they entered the Church and the Blessed Sacrament was desecrated, the sacred images, the furnishings destroyed and general damage to this heritage")

Gonila Gill (aged 38, wife of Husnain Jamil, mother, reported her family has been persecuted because her Muslim husband did not require her to convert to Islam, resigned from her journalism job, recently said "People are vile when they talk rubbish about my faith. However, I will not lose hope and remain steadfast in my religion...[I] received from God the gift of an honest husband, respectful of me and our son who we chose to baptize as a Christian. I am very grateful to him because he helps me and takes care of me, although he is also forced to endure the cruelty of people. He supports my son and I in our Christian life. He often comes to Mass with us and participates in prayers. I am lucky to be surrounded by people who love me, by friends who support me. I feel a sense of insecurity in living in this society, and I am very worried about my son's future")

India: Narayanpur district, Chhattisgarh state

Ramesh Kumar Usendi (convert, along with other converts were denied Adivasis [aboriginal] certificates, which are needed for higher education, said "We travelled about 62 kilometers [38.5 miles] to reach the district office and submitted our applications and waited for hours. The official called us and asked us if I and the youths were Christian. We answered, 'Yes.' He was very angry that we applied for caste certificates and started using filthy language against us. The officer then tore our application letters and dumped them in the dust bin and asked us to never appear before him...In the Hindu Sanghatan [Hindu Union] meetings, they are told that Christian Adivasis would compete against them for government jobs. They want to limit our access to higher education and government benefits. In Orcha village alone, there must be at least 500 to 600 Christians who suffer this social inequality. Christian youths have at least studied 10th grade, but most of them do not possess a caste certificate")

Pastor Jin Wook Kim (aged 41, husband of Jung In Jiang, father of one son and expectant father, South Korean citizen, stabbed to death, had received death threats for his missionary work)

Jung In Jiang (widow of Pastor Jin Wook Kim, mother, South Korean citizen, gave birth to a daughter 5 days after his murder, later wrote a letter to his murderer forgiving him and stating she will pray for him to go to heaven, said she will stay in Turkey)

Pastor Li Juncai (arrested along with three other parishioners while protesting the government's February 20, 2019 removal of a cross from the roof of their church; **UPDATE**: still in jail, elderly mother still in residence in their church despite no utilities to prevent its demolition)

Thursday November 21, 2019



India

The August 2019 abrogation of the Indian Constitution provisions regarding Jammu and Kashmir and the imposition of direct rule from New Delhi resulted in a curtailment of organized Christian worship

Pastor Vishnu Dev (said from Ludhiana district, Punjab state "It has always been difficult for missionaries and pastors to serve in Jammu and Kashmir region, but the latest move taken by the Indian government abrogating Article 370 has stirred the anger of dominant Islamic community...At the most, five families would gather in a house and would pray in secret. Microphones and large congregations have disappeared. It is saddening that the religious freedom situation for Christians in the valley is only getting worse")

India: Srinagar, Jammu

Pastor Lance Thomas (husband, under constant surveillance by police and Hindu extremists including phone taps, said "I can't communicate much over the phone right now, and because of the Internet clamp down, it would be very difficult to write an email also, as only one government cyber-cafe is open")

India: Rajouri district, Jammu

Pastor Jeewer Joeswa (said "In Kashmir Valley, the curfew is still on, There are very few churches in the region, and nowhere will you find open worship as a congregation. All Sunday gatherings are done secretly inside a Christian's home, hiding from the police and neighbors...It was a total blackout – we had no access to phone lines or Internet when the government was deciding to abrogate Article 370. The connections were restored in Jammu Region in a couple of days, but Srinagar still suffers an Internet clampdown, and we could not reach our pastors and Christians there for weeks")

India: Taraibeda village, Kondagaon district, Chhattisgarh state

Pastor Sadhu Kashyap (abducted from a house church worship service on April 16, 2017, beaten, arrested on charges of causing annoyance in public places by singing or uttering obscenities, voluntarily causing hurt and criminal intimidation, hospitalized, later said "...we had decided to hold the worship service as it was Easter Sunday, and the believers were observing fast the previous three days. Suddenly two persons barged inside the home church and asked me to come out, and that they wanted to talk to me. I reluctantly went to enquire what the matter was. They held my hands tight, caught me by the collar and took me onto the road...Some of them kicked me with shoes and beat me up with sticks. I almost fell unconscious, and they boarded me on a vehicle and took me to the police station in Kondagaon. I remember that I was fainting, and they stopped at a hotel, sprinkled some water on my face and forcefully made me drink the water. Later I was handed to the police. My health was degrading, and I was soon fully unconscious"; UPDATE: charges dismissed)

Auxiliary Bishop Theodore Mascarenhas SFX (**UPDATE**: reported on continuing harassment of Catholic adoption agencies "It is not just the sisters of Mother Teresa who are under attack. The Jesuits are under investigation in two proceedings, then also the Ursuline nuns. They attack us because the sisters look after people who are rejected in society, dying and suffering. They would like to paint us like thieves, sellers of children. They know that if they physically attack us, we become stronger. While it is easier to attack ourselves morally. They want us to lose credibility but we are strong in faith. Let us move forward in our service of love for the poor. It is the Lord who gave us this task")

Fr Edwin Roman (held by police in his church on November 16, 2019 along with relatives of political prisoners who had begun a hunger strike, police turned off all utilities to the church and arrested all who tried to bring food and water; **UPDATE**: hospitalized after the Red Cross negotiated the police withdrawal from the church)

India: Mirtur village, Bijapur district, Chhattisgarh state

Anjali Kadti (aged 17, daughter of Ramvati Kadti, died after a month long battle with malaria, denied burial)

Ramvati Kadti (mother of Anjali Kadti, told by the village chief that her daughter's burial would be permitterd only if she converted to the Adivasi religion, refused)

Pastor Chapdi (described the conflict over the burial of Anjali Kadti: "The villagers threatened Ramvati Kadti, saying that she is only a woman and that she cannot perform the last rites without the support of village council. But she stood firm in faith and declined their offer. The villagers along with at least 200 Hindu extremist RSS [Rashtryia Swayamsevak Sangh paramilitaries] and Bajrang Dal activists did not let us bury the body for two days...We spent an entire day pleading with them to allow the burial. They finally agreed [under police pressure] and gave a small piece of land under a tree")

Tuesday November 26, 2019



India: Perigaon village, Rayagada district, Odisha state

Pastor Bibudhan Pradhan (helped parishioners after they were attacked by Adivasi [aboriginal tribal] radicals on November 26, 2019: "They were horrified by what happened...The drunk men abused the Christian families in filthy language and forcefully searched their homes for Bibles. The Christians tried hard to resist them to no avail. They gathered the Bibles from Christian homes at one spot at the center of the village, poured kerosene and lit fire"; UPDATE: attacked, said "After we concluded the prayers and community lunch service, a batch of around 15 tribal men came with axes, surrounded the church and threatened that they will chop us into pieces. They took us inside the village and held us hostage for more than four hours. They abused us in vulgar language, words that I can't utter with my mouth, and threatened us that their gods and goddesses will swallow us alive for propagating Christianity in an Adivasi [indigenous tribal] hamlet", released, church building destroyed in an arson attack that night)

Ramy Kamel (Coptic activist, **UPDATE**: reported to have been arrested for posting videos of Christians being forcibly evicted from their homes in the south of the country)

Mina Thabet (**UPDATE**: said that Ramy Kamel had been threatened with arrest by the security services for weeks for his social media posts which documented persecution, said the arrest was "farcical", added "The Sisi government is waging a war against its opposition, rather than a war against terrorism")

Indeed life is quite difficult for me and the children. I have realized that following Jesus is not easy. Sometimes I spend sleepless nights thinking on my future and that of my small kids, especially their school fees")
